Your Complainant further states - That Solomon Snowden died intestate, on or about the first day of February eighteen hundred & fifty three seized of certain Real Estate, Situate in Frederick County and fully described in the Copy of said Deed filed in the proceedings as Exhibit E as well appear upon reference thereto, and that letters of administration, upon his personal Estate, were only granted by the Orphans Court of Frederick County to Ezra Doubt as will appear from an exemplification thereof herewith exhibited as exhibit C Your Complainant further states - that Solomon Snowden left a widow by the name of Sophia Snowden, and the following children to wit, George Snowden, Mary Snowden, and Margaret Snowden, all of whom reside in Frederick County, and all of full age of Twenty one years, except Margaret Snowden, who is still a minor Your Complainant further states, that the personal Estate of which said Snowden died seized is utterly insufficient to pay his debts, and that recourse must be had to his Real, and a sale made thereof - for that purpose - In-lender Considered whereof, and for as much as your Complainant is remediless in the premises by the strict rules of Law - and only relievable in a Court of Equity where matters of this nature are properly cognizable, and to the end that the Real Estate whereof said Solomon Snowden died seized - may be sold, under a Decree of this Honorable Court, and the proceeds of sale applied to the payment of his debts, and to
