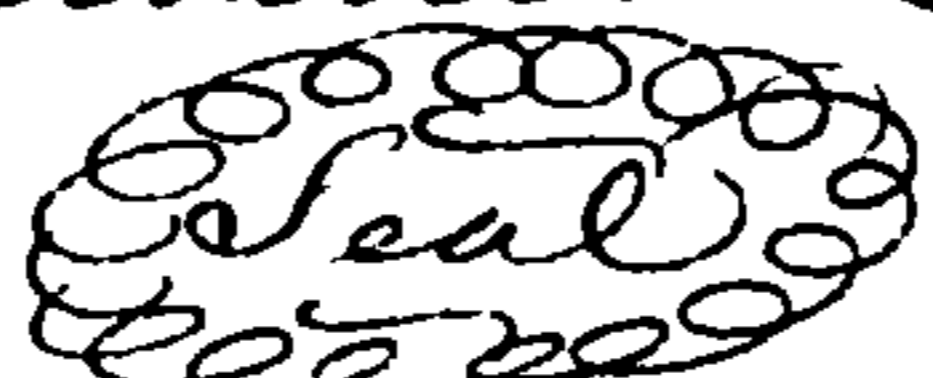

at the request of Solomon Snowden the following deed is Recd, the 28th day of September 1836

This Indenture made this Twenty eighth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six Between William McAlbaugh, and Susannah Albaugh his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland of the one part; and Solomon Snowden of the County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth. That the said William McAlbaugh & Susannah Albaugh for & in Consideration of the sum of seventy five dollars Current money of the United States to them in hand paid the said Solomon Snowden, before the sealing, and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said William McAlbaugh & Susannah Albaugh doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted bargained sold, aliened enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell, alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Solomon Snowden, his heirs & assigns, all that following described part or piece of a Lot of ground, situate lying in Frederick Town, and the same more particularly distinguished as being a part of Lot No 12. in the addition to Frederick Town - the said part of the aforesaid Lot No 12 fronting on Fifth Street, one half its width 31 feet more or less from the South East end, and running Back with said whole Lot in depth one half its length and being the same width at the back, or North end, as in front it being a part of the same Lot of ground, which was on the nineteenth day of October 1831 - Conveyed by a certain Jacob Rowd and Susannah Rowd his wife - to the aforesaid William McAlbaugh - Together with all & singular the buildings Improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversions, and remainders, rents issues, and profits thereof, and all the Estate, right Title & Interest whatsoever of them the said William McAlbaugh and Susannah his wife, both at law and in Equity, of in to and out of the said part, or piece of Lot and premises hereby bargained, and sold, or meant mentioned, or intended hereby to be, and every or any part and parcel thereof.
