ick County sitting as a Court of Equity The Bill of Complaint of Frederick Slagle &
Samuel Maught of Frederick County shows That on the sixth day of August -
eighteen hundred and fifty two a certain William Maught of said County being
indebted, unto your orator Frederick Slagle in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars
current money, and intending to secure the payment thereof, unto your said orator
did by his deed of that date, convey unto your orator, and his heirs, certain Real
Estate, lying in said County, and particularly described in said deed To which said deed
there is a condition annexed that it be void on payment of your orator Frederick
Slagle, his executors administrators or assigns the said sum of Five Hundred dollars
with legal Interest for the same, when the said William Maught should be there
unto requested all of which will fully appear by reference to a Copy of said
deed of Mortgage herewith exhibited, marked exhibit N^o 1 which with all
other exhibits your orators pray may be taken as part of this Bill of Complaint
Your orators further show, unto your Honor - that on the 31st of May eighteen
hundred, and fifty three, the said William Maught, being indebted to your orator
Samuel Maught, in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars - current money and intending
to secure the payment thereof, did by his deed of that date, convey unto your orator
Samuel Maught, his heirs, and assigns, certain Real Estate, lying in said County -
being in part the same mentioned in the aforesaid deed to your orator Frederick
Slagle, and particularly described in said deed to which said deed there is a con-
dition annexed - that it be void on payment to your orator Samuel Maught of
the said Five Hundred dollars with legal Interest, on or before the first day of
June eighteen hundred and fifty four, and your orator files herewith a Copy of
said deed, marked Exhibit N^o 2 Your orators further show, unto your Honor
