

State of Maryland Justice On this 9<sup>th</sup> day of January 1855 before the undersigned a Justice of the peace of the state of Maryland, in and for Frederick County, personally appeared Henry Maught, & muss Bath, that he knew William Maught That said William Maught is dead, that he did not leave personal property, sufficient to pay his debts That he left a Negro woman, between seventy five, and eighty years of age, who by reason of her age & decrepitude is wholly unable, & unable to get a livelihood & maintenance

Sworn Before M. Daltzell,

On reading the foregoing Petition and affidavit, and appearing that the Petitioner is entitled to the relief prayed It is thereupon this 9<sup>th</sup> January 1855 Ordered that in stating the account in this case, the auditor, out of any surplus, after payment of debts, amount to the Trustee to be invested, or held for the support of said Negro the sum of Five hundred Dollars and that said Trustee apply the annual Interest of said sum towards support of said Negro, and that on the death of said Negro said Trustee report said sum to this Court
