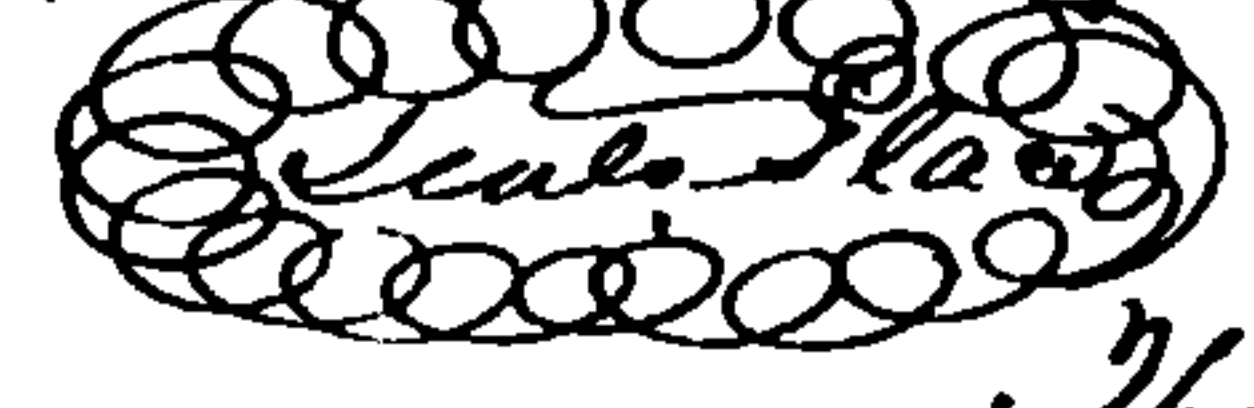
At the Execution of the annexed Commission issued out of the Circuit Court, for Frederick

 examine Levi N. Ohler one of the defendants, under an order of Court directing the same
 on Interrogatories herewith filed & returned, on the part of the Complainant.

Levi N. Ohler duly sworn of lawful age answers To the 1st Int^y He is acquainted
 with the parties - Complainant & defendant & for some years To 2^d Int^y He answers
 He was acquainted with David F. Wächter of Frederick County He is dead he died on the
 3^d July 1854 He left two children both under 21 years of age viz Edward R. & Robert D.
 Wächter both quite young. To the 3^d Int^y he answers - That David F. Wächter died with-
 out a will and that Joshua Dill - was appointed by Ophians Court administrator of
 said D. F. Wächter's estate (exemplification filed To the fourth Int^y he answers -
 That Solomon Ohler & John Wächter were the purchasers of the Real Estate conveyed
 to David F. Wächter as Trustee & mentioned in these proceedings the amount \$1750 that
 about \$1100 is still to be paid That David F. Wächter did not fully execute his trust
