 Ferry Savings Institution, which said Institution is a Body Politic, and Corporate duly
 Created, and Organized by the Laws of the State of Virginia Respectfully Shews to your
 Honors - That one Joseph G. Hays late of Jefferson County in the State of Virginia
 who has since deceased in his life time being largely indebted to the said Harpers Ferry
 Savings Institution, to wit: On the 14th day of December A.D. 1840 in the sum of Four
 thousand, seven hundred and ninety five dollars and forty seven Cents, for the purpose
 of securing the said sum of money made and executed his seven several Single bills;
 payable to the said William Anderson, as the Treasurer of the said Institution to & for
 the purpose, use and benefit of the said Institution, in the sums, and at the times
 following, to wit the first for the sum of six hundred dollars payable the first day of
 January A.D. 1843 the second for six hundred dollars, payable the first day of January
 A.D. 1844 the third for six hundred dollars payable January the first, 1845 the
 fourth for six hundred dollars payable January 1st 1846 the fifth for six hundred
 dollars payable January 1st 1847 the sixth for six hundred dollars payable July 1st A.D.
 1848 and the seventh for five hundred & ninety five dollars and forty seven Cents -
 payable January the first A.D. 1849 and the same day to wit December 14 1840 executed
 a Deed of Mortgage of a parcel of Land in Frederick County aforesaid, containing eighty-
 acres to said William as Treasurer as aforesaid to secure the payment of said notes
