Witnesseth - That the said Lawrence has sold unto the said Hays
his drug & medicine Store at Harpers Ferry - Together with the books -
Notes accounts and effects of the said Store for which the said Hays
is to pay the debts of the said Store, which Augustus M Conder has
incurred thereon, and as soon after as may be convenient the said
Hays binds himself to sell his farming Implements Together with
his Stock at a credit of six months and to take notes bearing In-
terest from date with good and sufficient securities & to transfer to the
said Lawrence notes amounting to one thousand dollars together with
the Interest that may accrue on the one thousand dollars from this
date to the time the transfer shall be made on the said notes as Witness
