Devilbess, has taken out Letters of Administration from the Orphans Court of said County, upon his Estate, and that the personal Estate of said deceased is greatly insufficient to pay his debts, and that it is expedient - That his Real Estate aforesaid should be sold - under a decree of this Court and the proceeds thereof applied to pay said debts so far as said personalty is insufficient for that end To the end therefore - That said Real Estate may be sold for the payment of the debts of said Decd and that the whole balance of purchase money due to said John Debow may be fully paid, and your orator Adam and the other creditors of said Decd. may out of the residue be paid and satisfied - the several debts and that the several defendants, hereinafter named may answer the premises, & That your orator may have such other, and full relief, as the nature of their case may require may it please your Honor to grant unto your orators the styles writ of subpoena, against the said Adam W Devilbess as administrator as aforesaid, and the said Rufus W Devilbess, Amos W Devilbess, George A Devilbess and Henry C Devilbess, commanding them to be and appear in this Court, on or before some day therein to be named to answer the premises, and shew cause if anything should why a decree should not pass as prayed & as induty bound &c.
