

The said Daniel G Geller is entitled to certain credits the same as given by endorsement on the said assigned notes. But your Complainants charge that with the exception of the said credits admitted as above the whole principal and Interest, accruing upon said claims now held by your Complainants is still due and unpaid, and although the time fixed in the Conditions of the mortgages exhibited has long since passed, and frequent demands made upon the said Daniel G Geller his heirs & your Complainants have failed to obtain either payment or satisfaction for their claims your Complainants further state that said Daniel G Geller died intestate some months since in the City of Baltimore, and at the time of his death he left a widow by the name of Elizabeth, and the following children to wit Joseph A Geller - John - May - Wella - Rose - Edward - Peter and - George Geller, all of whom reside in the City of Baltimore, and are minors with the exception of Joseph A Geller who is of the full age of twenty one years. Intender Consideration whereof and for as much as your Complainants are sensible in the premises by the strict rules of the Common Law, and only relievable in a Court of Equity, where matters of this nature are properly cognizable - and to the end that the said Elizabeth Geller Joseph A Geller - John Geller May Geller Wella Geller Rose Geller Edward Geller Peter Geller, and George Geller and the said Chauncy Brooks and Henry W. Stuedt trading as Brooks & Stuedt may answer the several matters and things herein charged, the said parties of full age, under their Corporal Oaths, and the said Infants by their guardian assigned, as fully as if they were specially - interrogated thereto, and to the end - that the whole of the Estate aforesaid, or so much as may be necessary - may be sold for the payment of your Complainants claims both principal and Interest, and that your Complainant may have all such other, and further relief in the premises as may be consistent with Equity and the nature of their case. May it please your Honor to grant unto your Complainants the writ of Subpoena in the usual form against the said Elizabeth Geller Joseph A Geller John Geller May Geller Wella Geller Rose Geller Edward Geller, Peter Geller and George Geller - and against the said Chauncy Brooks & Henry W. Stuedt and to the Sheriff of Baltimore to be directed - Commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court, in person or by solicitor upon a certain day in said Subpoena fixed to answer the premises, and abide by and perform such Decree as may be passed therein.
