



Exhibit B is as follows. Viz.

In the name of God, amen. I Valentine Schwartz Jnr. of Frederick-Town, Frederick County, and State of Maryland, being sick, and weak in body but of sound & disposing mind, memory, and understanding, do make and Ordain this my Last will, and Testament - in manner and form following, to wit: *Impressio.* It is my will, and desire that in the first place, all my just debts, and funeral expenses be paid off and satisfied. Item. I give, and devise, unto my sister Mary, wife of Thomas Hickson (after the death of my mother Susannah Schwartz, during her life, all that half Lot of ground & Improvements thereon I now live, know, and distinguish by No. 57, situate lying and being in Frederick Town, the said half Lot, lying next to and adjoining the Lot, now Conveyed by Nicholas Righler, and to extend back from Patrick Street, to Church Street, the full width of said half Lot, and after the decease of my said sister Mary Hickson - I will, and devise the said half Lot No. 57 to the Children of my said sister Mary Hickson, their heirs, and assigns forever. Item. I will and devise, unto Mary Wygall, daughter of my sister Margaret after the death of my said mother, and said sister, Margaret the other or remaining half of said Lot, & Improvements No. 57, the said half Lot, lying next to and adjoining the Lot, now occupied by Michael Olley, and to extend back from Patrick Street, to Church Street the full width of said half Lot, which said half Lot, and premises - I will, and devise to the said Mary Wygall, and to her lawful Issue forever, and for want of such issue, after the decease of the said Mary Wygall I will, and devise the said half Lot of ground, and Improvements to the Children of my said sister, Mary Hickson, and to the Children of my sister Susannah Schroeder, their heirs, and assigns forever. It I will, and bequeath unto Henry, William & Edward Schroeder (Children of my said deceased sister - Susannah -) their heirs & assigns the Three Shares, in the United States Loan Office, at Annapolis, as will to me by my deceased father Valentine Schwartz (my said mother to draw the Interest accruing on said Shares during her life - Item I will & bequeath unto Elizabeth Insler, daughter of Valentine Insler my feather bed, Bedstead & furniture thereunto belonging. Item I give and bequeath, unto my said mother Susannah Swartz, my eight day clock, and Case, desk, and kitchen Cupboard, and Lastly I do hereby ratify, and Confirm, this and now other to be my Last will, and Testaments. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, & seal, the fourth day of February, in the year of our Lord, Eighteen Hundred and Six.
