This Indenture made this 23^d. day of December in the year 1852. by and Between Lewis
V. Schell and Jennima Schell his wife of Frederick County, and State of Maryland
of the one part, and Cornelius Shriver of the County, and State aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth - That the said Lewis V. Schell, and Jennima Schell his wife, for, and in Con-
sideration of the sum of Eleven thousand Dollars, current money, to them in hand paid
by the said Cornelius Shriver, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the re-
ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed re-
leased, Conveyed, and Confirmed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain sell, alien
enfeoff, release, Convey, and Confirm, unto the said Cornelius Shriver his heirs and
assigns, the following pieces, or parts of tracts of Land, situate in Frederick County
State aforesaid, viz. all that piece or parcel of Land, called & known as the Lingans
Mills, with the Lands thereto attached, and also the piece or parcel of Land conveyed
by a certain David Kenaga, to Horatio M. Thuron, containing Together 112 acres of
Land, more or less, being the same parcels of Land, heretofore conveyed by Mary S. M^o
Thuron, John M. Thuron, and John K. Dall, to Samuel Canby, and Samuel Duer by old
