That a certain Albert G. Mayberry, late of said County decd. was in his life time indebted to your orator as surviving partner as aforesaid, in the sum of Six dollar. Current money, for work and labour, a particular account whereof, duly probated and passed is herewith exhibited, marked Exhibit N. 1. which with all other Exhibits your orator prays may be taken as part of this his bill of Complaint, your orator further shows. That the said Albert G. Mayberry in his life time, on the third day of January. eighteen hundred and Fifty four. purchased of a certain Jacob Litter of said County, a house and lot, situate in Frederick Town, for the sum of Two thousand dollars, as will appear by a Copy of the agreement of said sale, herewith filed, marked Exhibit N. 2. And your orator Charges. That one thousand Dollars of said purchase money - has been paid to the said Jacob Litter, and that the heirs at Law. of said Albert G. Mayberry own said House and lot Subject to the lien of the balance of said purchase money, and your orator further Charges. that said Albert G. Mayberry being indebted as aforesaid to your orator, and to divers other persons in large sums of money, and having said - Equitable interest in said Real Estate, and owning a small personal property, departed this life, some time in the summer of Eighteen hundred and Fifty four, intestate
