In consideration of which the said Conrad Hamburg covenants and agrees, to and with the said Abraham Stoner, to pay to the said Stoner Ten Dollars for each and every acre - contained as above, by giving his notes - with approved Securities (as follows) viz. One note for one Hundred Dollars, payable on the first day of April 1841. One note of Two hundred Dollars, payable on the first day of October 1841. also One note of Two hundred Dollars payable on the first day of October 1842. and a note for the remaining Balance on the first day of October 1843. all of said notes, bearing legal Interest from date till paid. So the true and faithful performance of the several Covenants, and agreements aforesaid the parties aforesaid do hereby respectively bind themselves and their respective heirs, executors, and administrators, each to the other his executors & administrators in the sum of One thousand Dollars. Current money. In Testimony where of the parties aforesaid hath hereunto subscribed their names & affixed their seals, the day & year first within written.


Two days after date. I promise to Abraham Stoner, or order the sum of Forty three Dollars for value received. Witness my hand, and seal, this first day of August, 1849.



If you fail you not, as you will answer the contrary at your peril. Witness the Hon. Madison Nelson, Judge of our said Court, the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1853. Issued 27<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1853. to the Sheriff of Frederick County.
