

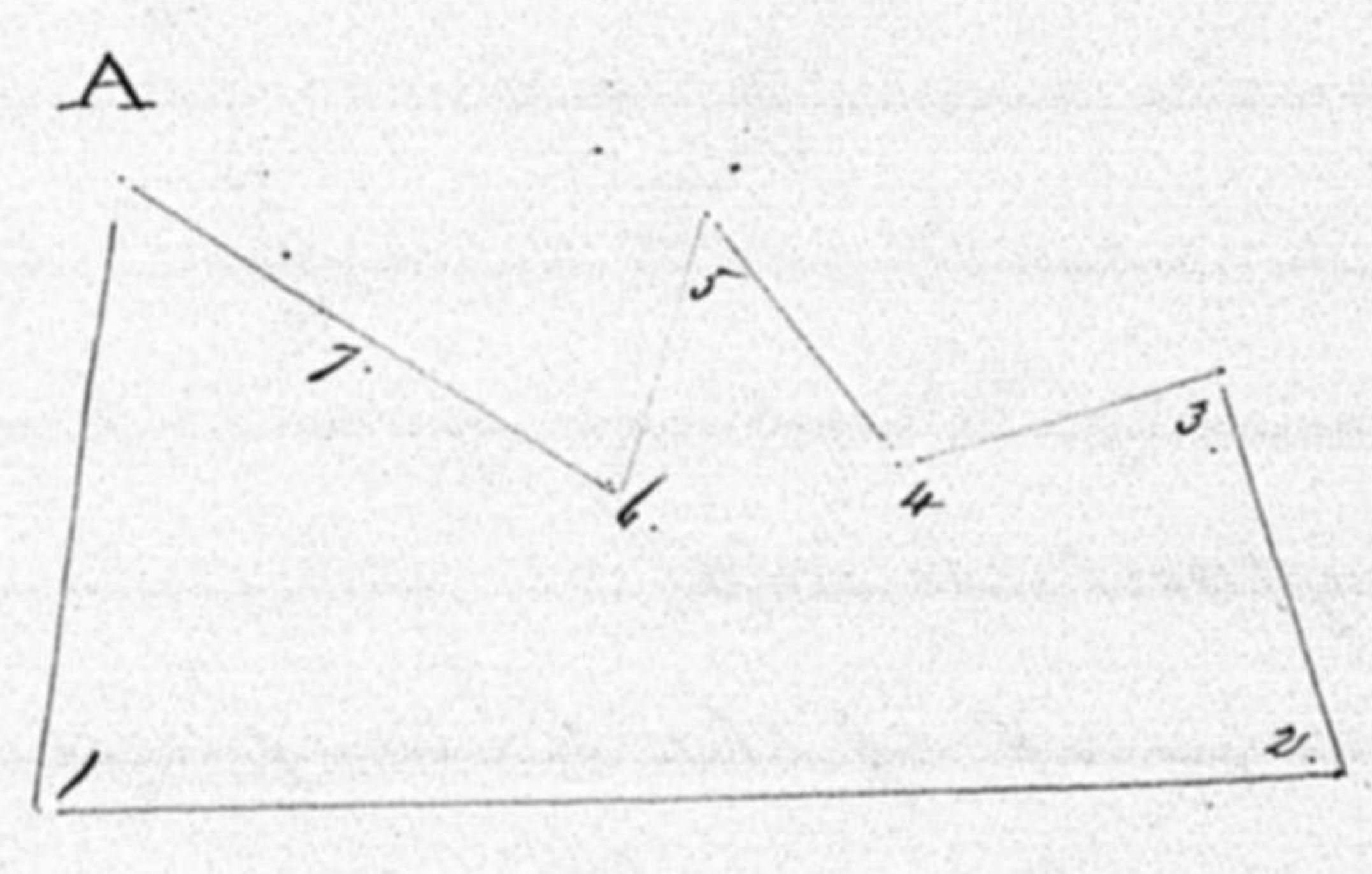

Lot N^o. 1. - The State of Maryland to wit. I do hereby certify - That at the request of the heirs of Levi Devilbiss deceased. I have surveyed, and laid out the following described parcel of land, lying in part in Frederick, and in part in Carroll Counties, being part of a Tract of Land called "Warfields Inheritance" Conveyed by Joshua Warfield and Jesse L. Warfield, Executors of Alexander Warfield dec^d. to Levi Devilbiss, and Thomas Devilbiss by deed bearing date the 11th day of April 1835. and by Thomas Devilbiss and Mary A. Devilbiss his wife to Levi Devilbiss, for their undivided one half part of the same by deed, dated the 10th day of December 1839, and included within the following metes and bounds. viz - Beginning at a stone now planted at the end of 11.6 ps. on the third line of 8 acres & 55 square perches, of Land part of Warfields Inheritance" included in the Deed from Joshua Warfield, & Jesse L. Warfield to Levi Devilbiss, and Thomas Devilbiss & running thence with, and bounding on said line, allowing 1 1/4" for retrograde variation. 1. S 43 1/4° E 24.4 ps to a stone at the end thereof. Lot N^o. 2. Part of a Tract of Land - called "Warfields Inheritance" which was Conveyed to Levi Devilbiss dec^d. and Thomas Devilbiss, as Tenants in Common by Joshua Warfield, Jesse L. Warfield, executors of Alexander Warfield dec^d. by deed bearing date the 11th day of April 1835. and by Thomas Devilbiss, and Mary A. Devilbiss his wife, for their undivided one half part of the same by deed, dated the 10th day of December 1839, also another part of said land which was conveyed to the said Levi Devilbiss by Jesse L. Warfield by deed, dated the 25th day of April 1839, and also part of Park Seal^d which was Conveyed by Thomas Ingles, and Margaret Ingles his wife, to Levi Devilbiss by deed bearing date the 3^d day of July 1841. - lying in Carroll County.

I do hereby certify that at the request of the heirs of Levi Devilbiss, dec^d. I have surveyed the above parcels of Land, and reduced the whole into one entire Survey, lying in Carroll County Md. and included within the following metes, and bounds viz. Beginning for the out lines including the same, at a stone heretofore planted at the Beginning of the deed from Jesse L. Warfield to Levi Devilbiss, and standing on the South side of Sams Creek, at the end of a line heretofore drawn S. 40° W 18 1/4 ps. from the end of the 40th line of the whole Tract, called Warfields Inheritance, and running thence reversing and bounding on the lines of said Deed, allowing 1 1/4 for retrograde variation.
