

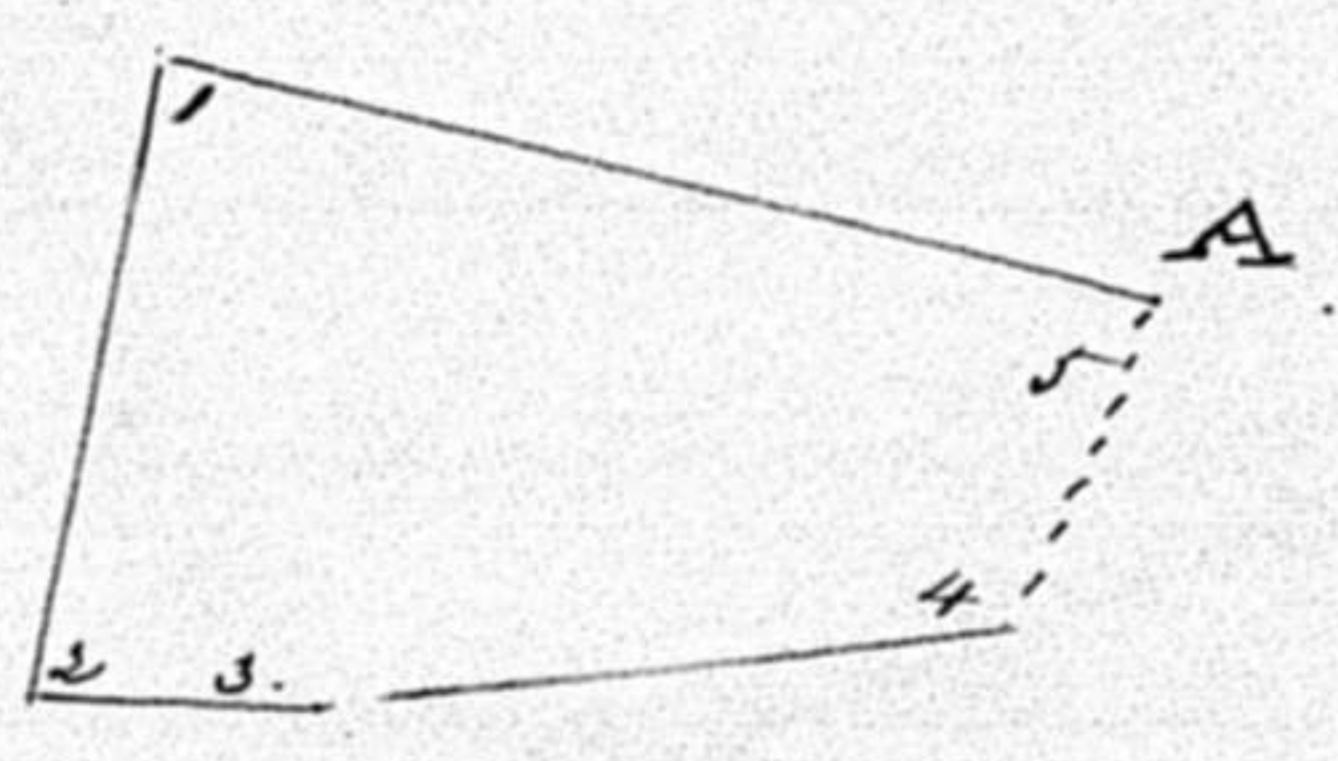

Lot No. 4. Part of a Tract of Land called "Caledonia" and part of a Tract called "Edenburgh" which was conveyed by Daniel Engel, Trustee of Thomas Ingles by deed, bearing date the 29th day of January, 1830 to Levi Deulbiss dec. lying in Carroll County.

Beginning for said part, at a stone marked 3, planted at the Beginning of the Deed from Daniel Engel Trustee of Thomas Ingles, to Levi Deulbiss aforesaid, and running thence with & bounding on the first lines thereof, allowing 1^o for retrograde variation to correspond with the original location thereof 1. S 13 1/2° W. 65 ps. then by a line of division 2. S 79 3/4° E. 41 3/4 ps. to a stone, at the end of the last line of the Deed from Levi Deulbiss & Sarah Deulbiss, his wife to George Shipley in the Washington Road, then 3. N. 9° E. 18 1/4 ps. 4. N. 8° W. 48 1/4 ps. to the end of 23 ps. on the 4th line of part of "Caledonia" conveyed by James Orr, to Basil Lucas, then reversing & bounding thence on, allowing 2^o for retrograde variation 5. N. 66 1/2° W. 23 ps. to the Beginning, containing containing 12 7/8 acres of Land

Lot No. 5. - Carroll County, Set.

I certify that I have, carefully surveyed, and laid down, for and at the request of Messrs George W. Deulbiss, and John Greenwood, administrators of Levi Deulbiss, late of Frederick County dec. all that piece, part of a Tract, or parcel of Land, situate, and lying in Carroll County aforesaid, called "Windsor Forrest Corrales" - that is contained within the following notes, and bounds, courses & distances to wit: Beginning for the same in the Centre, or middle of the New Road, leading from Baltimore to Liberty, at the end of 35 perches on the N 22° E 66 ps line of the Land called "Opfington Forrest, it being the 97th course thereof, and running thence with and bounding thereon, allowing one degree for variation, as follows, to wit: N 23° E 31 ps. N 23° 45' W 80 ps. to intersect the 210th course of the Land, called "Caledonia" thence running thence, and bounding thereon, run with one degree correction, as follows, to wit: S 68° E 52 ps. N 23.30 E 20 ps. to the middle or centre of the Old Road, leading from Liberty to Baltimore, thence running down with, and bounding on the Centre thereof S 39° 45' E 78 ps. to intersect the 15th line of the Land, called "Heudsons Forrest Resurveyed, thence running with and bounding on said Land, run, with two degrees allowance, for variation, as follows, to wit: S 32° W 7 ps. S 44° E 14 ps. S 29° W 56 ps. to the centre of the aforesaid "New Baltimore & Liberty Road, thence running up with, and bounding thereon, and with a straight line to the first mentioned place of Beginning, containing, and now laid out for 47 acres, 2 Rods & 20 perches of Land, more or less.
