



Lot N. 6. Carroll County Set. I certify that I have carefully surveyed, and laid down, for and at the request of Messrs George W. Devilbiss, and John Greenwood, administrators, of Levi Devilbiss, late of Frederick County deceased, all that piece, part of a Tract or parcel of Land, situate and lying in Carroll County aforesaid, called Windsor Forrest Corrected, that is contained within the following meter, and bounds, Courses & Distances, to wit: Beginning for the same, in the Centre of the Old Road, leading from Baltimore to Liberty, at the end of twenty perches, on, and in the North North east 40 ps line of the Land called "Caledonia". It being the 21th Course of said Land, & running thence with, and bounding thence on, as run with an allowance of one degree to correct the variation, the two following Courses, and Distances, to wit: N. 23° 30' E 21 ps. N. 64° E 49 ps. thence S 14° W 4 ps. to a Stone Still S. 14° W 37 ps. to a Stone S 39° 15' E. 24 ps. to a Stone S 63° 15' E. 15 1/2 ps. to a Stone hereto fore planted, at the end of the 14th Course of the Land called "Hudson's Forrest Resurveyed", thence running with, and bounding on said Land, as run with an allowance of Two degrees, to correct the variation - the following Course & Distance S 32° W 4 ps. to the Centre of the aforesaid Old Baltimore & Liberty Road, thence running with, and bounding on the middle, or Centre thereof, and with a straight line to the first mentioned place of Beginning. Containing & now laid out for 19 1/2 ams. of Land, more or less.
