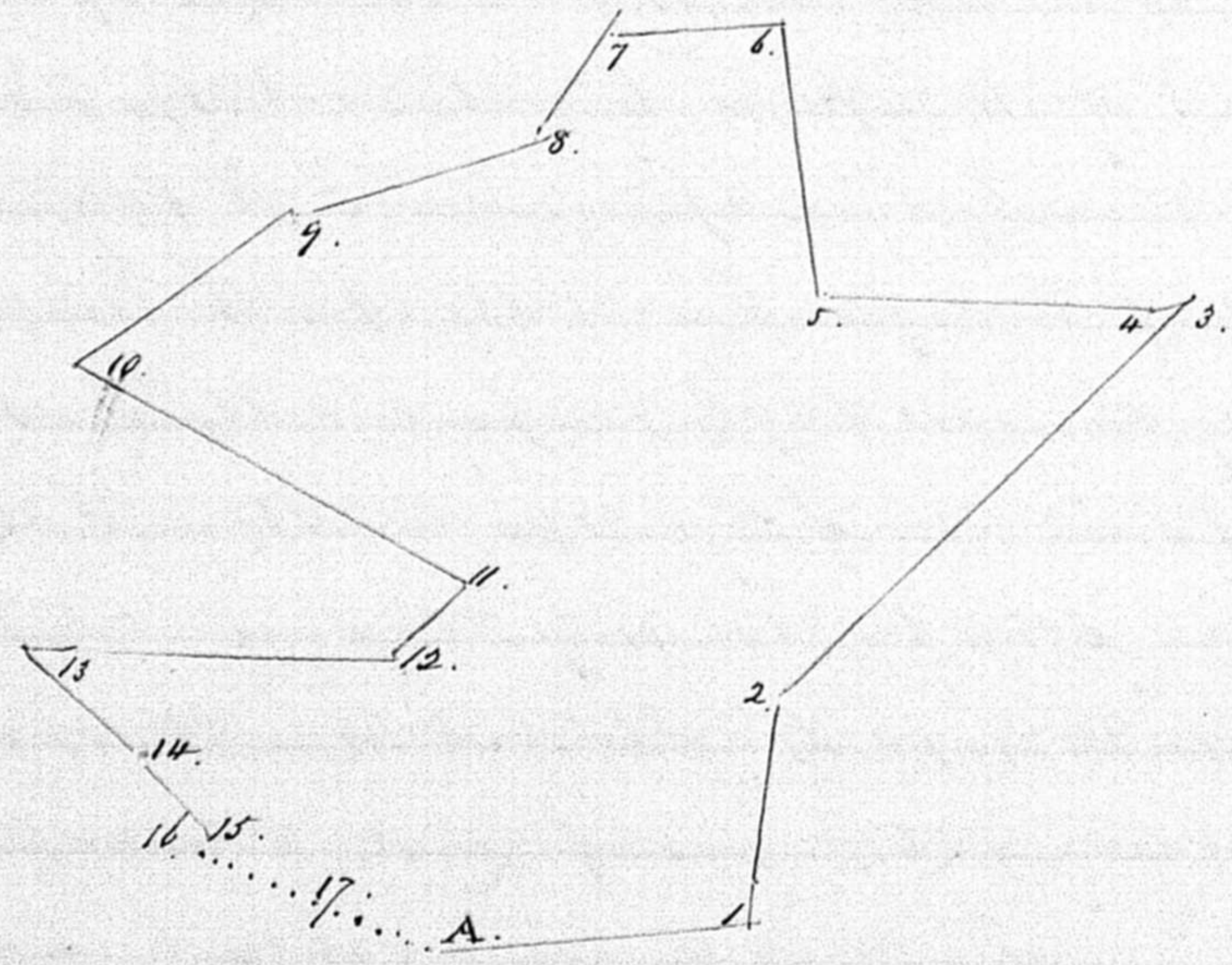


Lot N<sup>o</sup> 9. The State of Maryland. Frederick County to wit.

I do hereby Certify that at the request of the heirs of Levi Devilbiss deceased, I have surveyed and laid out the following described parcel of land, lying in Frederick County being part of a tract of land, called "Warfield's Inheritance" part of a Tract called "Leigh Castle" part of a tract called "Father's Gift" and part of a Tract called "Diffently" which was conveyed by Aaron & Mary Covee his wife, to Levi Devilbiss, by deed dated the day of 18. and included within the following notes, and bounds, viz. Beginning for the outline, including the same, at a stone heretofore planted, at the end of the 22<sup>d</sup> line of the whole Tract called "Warfield's Inheritance" and running thence reversing, and bounding on said line of division between Levi Devilbiss's land, and John R. Mills, allowing  $1/4^{\circ}$  for retrograde variation, to correspond, with their original location, allowing  $2^{\circ}$  for retrograde variation 1. S  $74^{\circ}$  W 51 ps. to a stone, then with, and bounding on lines of division between Levi Devilbiss's land, and John R. Mills, allowing  $1/4$  of a degree for retrograde variation, to correspond, with their original location 2. S  $1/4$  E  $36 1/4$  ps. to a stone 3. S  $32 1/4^{\circ}$  W. 91 ps. to a stone heretofore planted at a corner of their lands, and standing on a line of Caspar Devilbiss's land then bounding thereon 4. N  $60 1/4^{\circ}$  E. 7. 4 ps. to a stone, then with, and bounding on the lines of Abraham Kuebaum's land, connecting the courses, and distances to correspond, with stones formerly planted 5. N  $80^{\circ}$  E 52 ps. to a stone. 6. S  $19^{\circ}$  E. 44 ps. to a stone 7. N  $72^{\circ}$  E  $26 1/4$  ps. to a stone then 8. N  $23^{\circ}$  E 20 ps. to a stone. 9. N  $61^{\circ}$  E. 40 ps. to a stone 10. N  $42^{\circ}$  E. 42 ps. to a stone 11. N  $71^{\circ}$  W. 69 ps. to a stone 12. N  $34^{\circ}$  E. 16 ps. to a stone 13. N  $80^{\circ}$  E. 58 ps. to a stone, at the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> line of  $4 1/2$  acres of land, part of Leigh Castle, conveyed by Levi Devilbiss & Sarah Devilbiss his wife, to Boston Hammond, then with, and bounding on the lines thereof, allowing  $3/4^{\circ}$  for retrograde variation 14. N  $61 3/4^{\circ}$  W 26 ps. 15. N  $47 1/4^{\circ}$  W. 16 ps. to a stone planted, at the end of the 23<sup>d</sup> line of "Warfield's Inheritance" then with the 24<sup>th</sup> line of said land, allowing, as before 16. N  $8 1/4^{\circ}$  E. 2 ps. to a stone, then 17. N  $78^{\circ}$  W  $38 3/4$  ps. to the place of Beginning, Containing  $8 1/2$  acres of land

Lot N<sup>o</sup> 10. - Part of a Tract of land called "Leigh Castle," lying in Carroll County, Md. which was conveyed by Charles A. Warfield of A. to Levi Devilbiss. Beginning at the end of the second line of the deed from Levi Devilbiss to Boston Hammond, and running thence with and bounding on the lines thereof, three courses. S  $1 1/2^{\circ}$  W 20 ps. S  $42 1/2^{\circ}$  W. 25 ps. S  $32^{\circ}$  W 21.3 ps. to a stone planted, on the 2<sup>d</sup> line of the deed from Charles A. Warfield, to Levi Devilbiss, and with said line, allowing  $1 3/4^{\circ}$  for retrograde variation S  $49 1/2^{\circ}$  E  $23 1/10$  ps. to a stone formerly planted, still with and bounding on said deed. N  $44 1/4^{\circ}$  E.  $57 1/4$  ps. to a stone still with & bounding on the lines of said deed, allowing  $1 1/2^{\circ}$  for retrograde variation. N  $43 1/2^{\circ}$  W. 2 ps. to a stone N  $44^{\circ}$  E.  $5 1/10$  ps. to a white oak tree N  $64 1/4^{\circ}$  W. 25 ps. to a Black Oak tree. N  $37 3/4^{\circ}$  W.  $18 1/2$  ps. to the place of Beginning - Containing 11 acres, & 30 square perches of land.
