

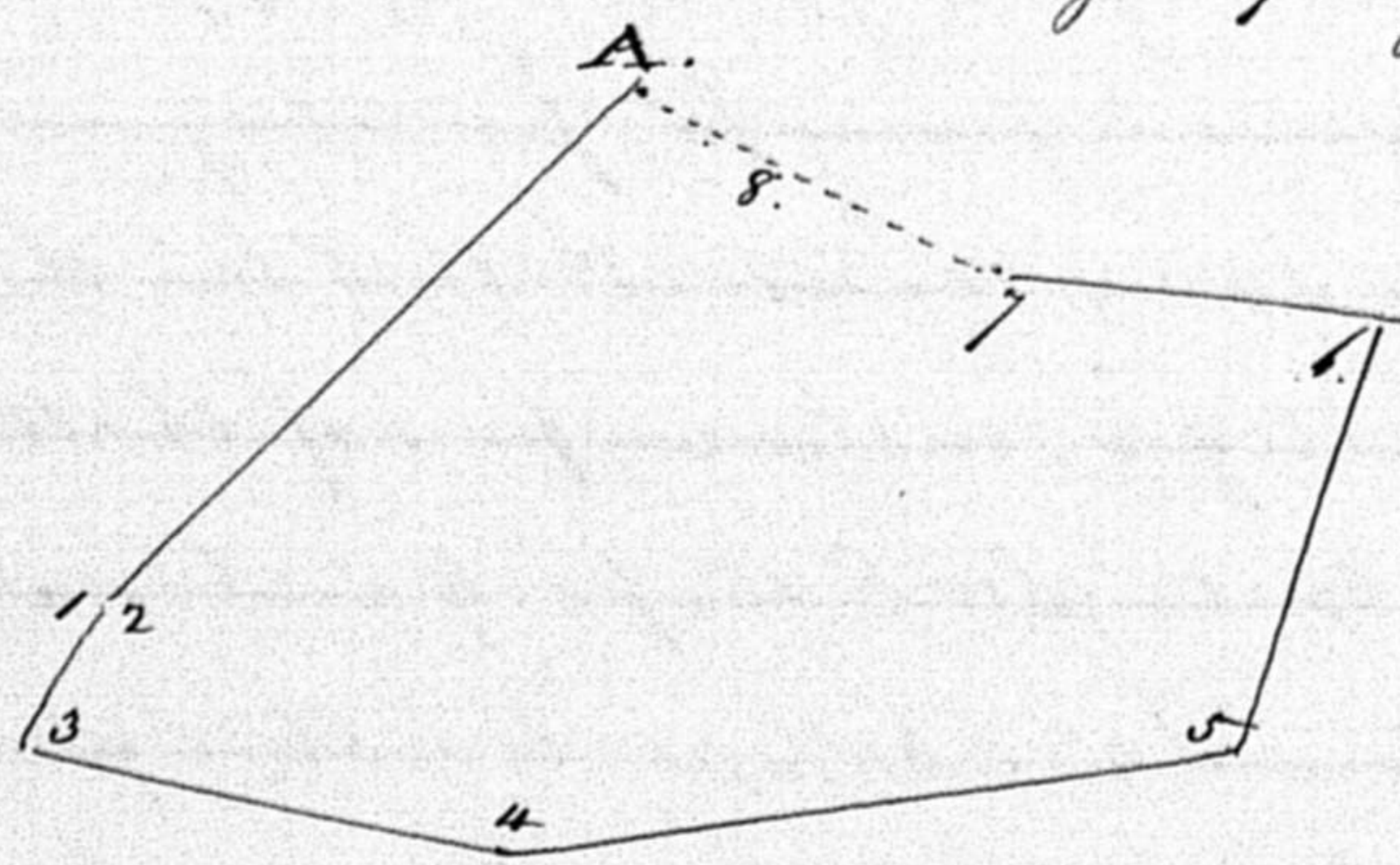

Lot N^o 13. The State of Maryland. Frederick County, to wit

I do hereby certify that at the request of the heirs of Levi Devilbiss deceased. I have surveyed and laid out, the following described parcel of land, lying in Frederick County, being part of a tract called "Quilting Frolic, and contained within the following metes & bounds, viz. lying in Frederick County.

Beginning for the out lines, including the same at a stone knots fore planted at the end of 42 1/4 ps on the 15th line of a tract of land called "Margarets Fancy" and running thence with and bounding on a division line - between Thomas Devilbiss & Levi Devilbiss allowing 3/4" for retrograde variation - to correspond with the original location thereof S. 77 1/4° E. 79.7 ps. to a line stone planted in the Public Road, then N. 2° W. 85/100 of a perch to a stone N. 89 1/2° E. 15.9 ps. to a stone planted on the 14th line of 3 3/8 acres of land part of Caspers Jess' Conveyed by Levi Devilbiss & Sarah Devilbiss his wife to Frederick Eckes, then reversing said line & bounding thereon N. 21° W. 52 ps. to a stone at the beginning thereof, it being also the end of the 3^d line of the deed from Levi Devilbiss, and Sarah Devilbiss to Jacob Landis, then with and bounding on the given line of said deed N. 37 1/4° W. 73 ps. to a stone, at the Beginning thereof, it being the end of the 15th line of Margarets Fancy, then with and bounding on the lines of said land, allowing 1 1/4" for retrograde variation S. 77° W. 50 1/4 ps. to a stone S. 17 3/4° E. 38.7 ps. to a stone S. 7 1/4° E. 42 1/4 ps. to the place of Beginning, containing & now laid out for 43 7/8 acres of land.
