



Thereupon the following subpoenas were issued to wit:

Thereupon the following Order was passed

The Frederick Town Savings Institution. N<sup>o</sup> 256. Equity. In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, February Term 1854. The object of the bill filed in this cause is to obtain a decree for the sale of the Real Estate, whereof William Watson dec'd seized, and to apply the proceeds to the payment of his debts his personal Estate not being sufficient. The Bill states - That said William Watson departed this life intestate in Frederick County, in or about the month of August, Eighteen hundred and fifty one, and seized of certain parcels of Real Estate, in said County, referred to in one of the exhibits, filed as part of the bill and that letters of administration, upon his personal Estate, were duly granted by the Orphans Court of Frederick County, to Mary Watson. The Bill further states, That the said William Watson, left the following heirs at law, viz. Conrad Watson, Daniel Watson, Ephraim Watson, Catharine Hamilton, Susan Hamilton, Elizabeth Banks, Thomas Banks, Isaac Banks, and Banks - John Watson, William Watson & Susan Watson all of whom are non residents of the State of Maryland, and Martha Watson, Elizabeth Fox, Jane Ann Rizer, - married to John Rizer, and Isaac Watson, residents of Frederick County. The Bill then states - That William Watson, died considerably involved - that his personal Estate will prove utterly insufficient, to pay his debts, and that it will require the sale of the greater part, if not the whole of the Real for that purpose, and prays that the same may be sold, and the proceeds distributed. It is thereupon this second day of June, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty four - Ordered by Edward Shriver Clerk to the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, That the Complainants by causing a Copy of this Order be inserted in some News paper published in Frederick County, from time to time, during not less one month from the date of said Order, give notice to the said Non resident defendants of the object and substance of the said Bill of Complaint, and warn them to appear in -
