


In the name of God - amen. I William Hallenberger of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, being sick and weak in body - but of sound & disposing mind, memory and understanding. Considering the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence, do therefore make, and publish this my last will, and testament, in manner & form following - that is to say - First and principally, I Commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried, at the discretion of my Executor herein after named, and after my just debts, and funeral charges are paid. I devise & bequeath as follows. Item. It is my will, and desire - That my Executor herein after named shall make sale of all my personal property, and of the proceeds pay my just debts, and when the debt that I owe on the Farm I now reside on shall be paid, my will and desire is - that the Conveyance, or Deed shall for the said Farm shall be made, unto my beloved wife - Elizabeth Hallenberger, for her to Have, Hold & occupy the said Farm, for and during her natural life, and after her death - the said shall be sold, and the proceeds to be equally divided, among all my children, in Equal portions, share and share alike. Item. I would also authorize my beloved wife Elizabeth - that provided - that she and a majority of my (children) children should find it more convenient, or advantageous, and agree to sell the said farm in her life time - That they may do so, provided they can agree on the distribution of proceeds among themselves, and finally - I do hereby constitute, and appoint my friend George Schlosser, Esq^r to be my sole executor of this my last will and Testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me made, ratifying & confirming this & none other, to be my last will and Testament. In Testimony whereof - I have hereunto set my hand, and affix^d my seal, this 25th day of Sept. 1848.

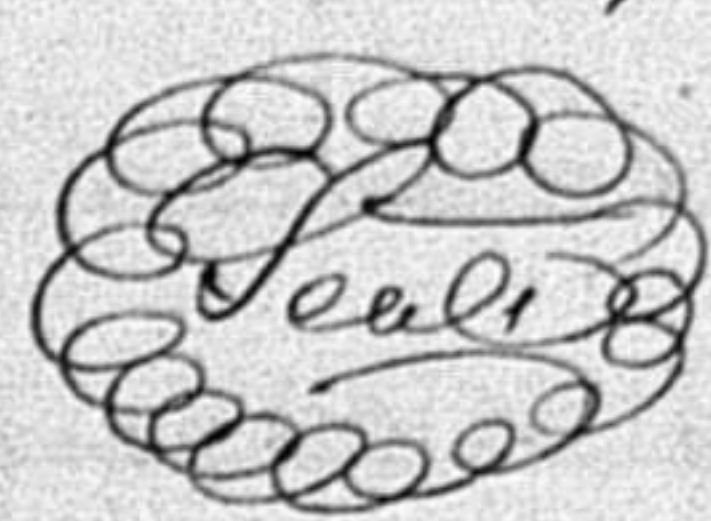

This Indenture - made this 19th day of February, in the year of our Lord, Eighteen Hundred, and fifty. Between George Beckenbaugh & Martha V. Beckenbaugh his wife, and George Beckenbaugh, E. M. Bartholow and Tideman Hull, Executors of Valentine Shryock, late of Frederick County - deceased of the one part and Elizabeth Hallenberger of Frederick County - Md. of the other part; Whereas Valentine Shryock, late of Frederick County dec^d by his last will, and Testament, bearing date the 26th day of September, in the year of our Lord, eighteen Hundred, and forty Three, and recorded in the office
