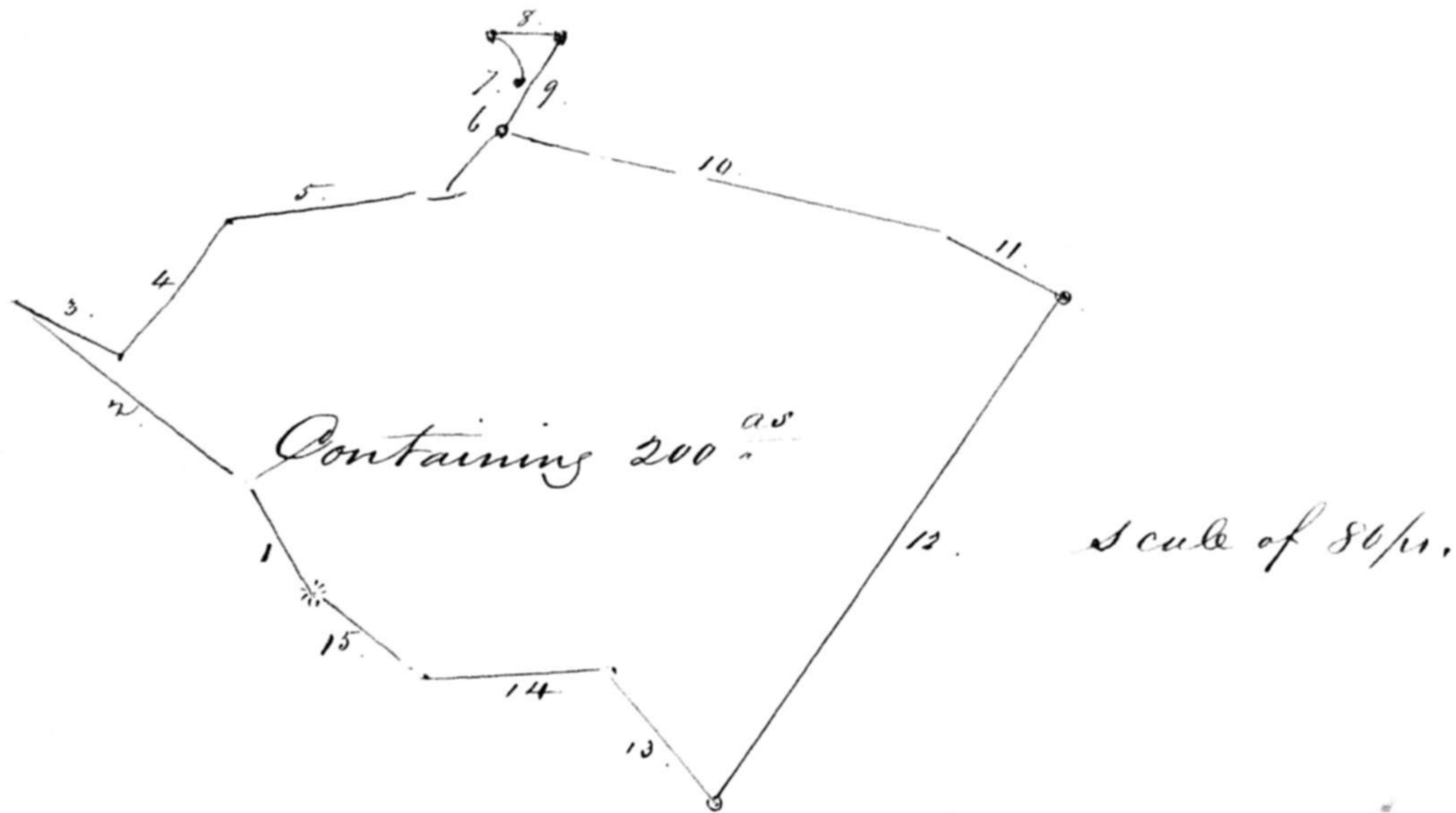

S 27 1/4° W 41 ps. to a stone at the end of the 14th line of the Deed from John D. Zimmerman, Esq. to Joseph Eichelberger, and with the fifteenth line thereof, Correcting the same N 54 1/2° W 154 ps. then by divisional lines N 54° E 50 1/2 ps. then by a straight line to the end of 40 ps. on the 1st line of the Stone Property, then by and with said 1st line rounded to the Beginning - Containing 200^{ac} more or less.

N. 67 3/8° E 36 ps. W 15 50' W 33 ps. S 58 1/4° W 7 ps. S. 66 1/2° W 18 ps." then by a straight line to the Beginning Containing 6^{ac} more or less.
