"The last will, and Testament, of me, William Fischer of the City of Washington, in the District of Columbia, I nominate, constitute, and appoint Harriet my wife, and my brother, George J. Fischer, executrix & executor of this my last will - I give, and devise, unto my mother, Elizabeth Fischer for her life, the two story Brick dwelling house, situate, in Frederick-town, in the State of Maryland, on Lot No. 275, with the ground and appurtenances thereto belonging, and the vacant lot of ground, lying on the west side of, and adjoining the same premises, and from, and after her decease - I hereby authorize, empower, and direct my said executrix & executor, and the survivor of them & the executors & administrators of such survivor, to sell & dispose of & convey the said premises with the appurtenances, together, or in parcels, and by public, or private sale, or sales for the best price, or prices, that can be reasonably obtained for the same, and to receive the rents thereof, from the death, until the same shall be sold, and I give, and bequeath - all the money to arise from such sale, and from the receipts of the rents & profits of the said premises, from my said mother's death, unto my four - sisters, Miranda Shipman, Margaret Lombard, Ann Eliza Cauliflower, and Sarah Bevan, to be equally divided between them share and share alike, and to be paid to them, as soon as conveniently can be, after my said mother's death - And in Case any of my said sisters shall die in the life time of my said mother, leaving any child or children surviving her, then I give, and bequeath to such child, or children, the part or share of such sister, so dying, to be equally divided, between them, if more than one, and the remaining third part thereof, unto my Nephew, George
