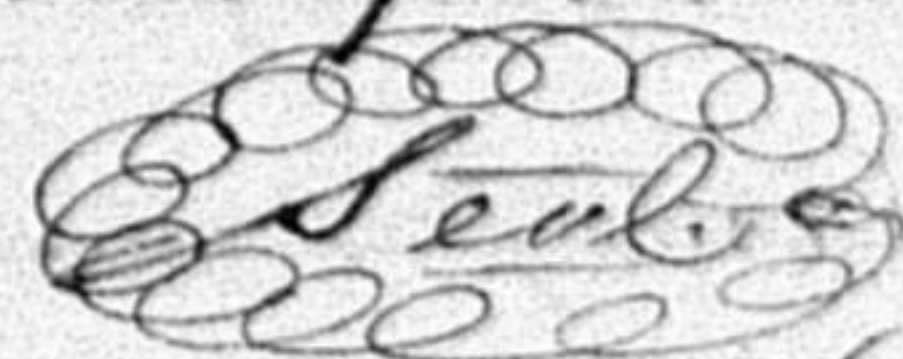

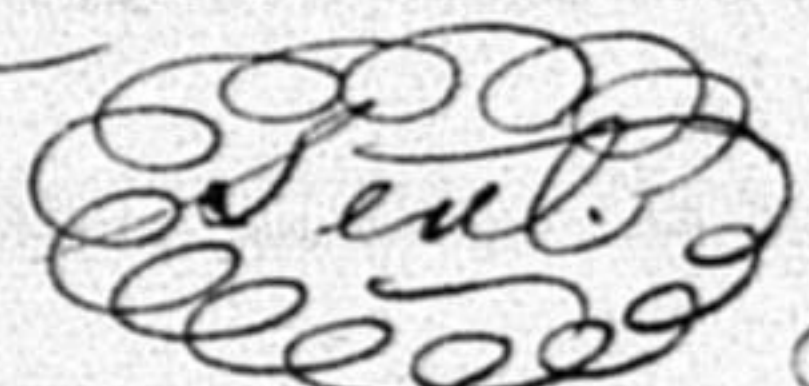

United States of America, Washington County, District of Columbia, to wit; To all to whom, these presents shall come - Greeting: Know ye - that on the eighteenth day of February, in the year of our Lord, 1852. Lettus Testametary, of all and singular the goods, Chattels, and Credits, which were of William Fischer, late of Washington, County, D.C. deceased, was by the Orphans Court of Washington-County aforesaid, granted, and committed unto Harriet Fischer of the County, and district aforesaid, and George J. Fischer of the State, they having first entered into Bond, with approved securities, for the faithful performance of the duties thereof: Witness - William F. Purcell, Esq: Judge of the Orphans Court of Washington County District of Columbia, this 15th day of June Anno Domini 1854.

Fischer of Frederick County - Greeting, you are hereby Commanded, that all excuses, set apart, you personally appear before the Judge of - the Circuit Court, for Frederick-County, sitting as a Court of Equity to be held at the Court House, in Frederick-town, in and for said County, on the first Monday of July next, to answer the Bill and Complaints of Joseph Devan & wife, & others, against you, in our said Court exhibited & so forth. hereof, fail you not, as you will answer the Contrary at your peril. Witness the Hon. Madison Nelson, Judge of said Court, the 13th day of February, 1854. Issued the 14th day of June, 1854. To the Sheriff of Frederick County.

Thereupon the following order was passed

Joseph Devan & Sarah Devan N. 2561. In the Circuit Court, for Frederick his wife, William F. Cauliflower County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and Ann Eliza his wife & oth^{rs}. February Term, 1854.

The object of this suit, is to procure a Decree, for the conveyance, by John A. Steiner of certain Real Estate, for the use and benefit of Elizabeth Fischer during her life, and after her death to be sold, and the proceeds equally divided between Miranda Shipman Ann Eliza Cauliflower, Margaret Lombare, and Sarah Devan & to require Harriet Fischer & George, J. Fischer as executors of William Fischer (dec'd) to permit said Elizabeth Fischer, to enjoy, and occupy said Real Estate, during her life, and to account for, and pay over to her the rents & profits received from said lot, and premises since the death of William Fischer. The Bill states - That William Fischer, late of the City of Washington in the district of Columbia, on the 25th day of March 1846. made his last will, in due form of law, and thereby devised certain Real Estate, in
