with David Livers, of the State of Illinois, Henry Harbaugh, Margaret Bart-  
dell, Nancy Harbaugh, who intermarried, with Jacob Hawes, Catharine  
Harbaugh, who intermarried with Abraham Wetty, and Susan Harbaugh,  
who intermarried with William Johnson, and your orator, all of whom -  
reside in the State of Pennsylvania. your orator further states - that it will  
for the Interest, and advantage, of all parties - That the above tract of Land  
be sold, and the nett proceeds thereof divided among the aforesaid heirs -  
& your orator prays your Honor, to appoint a Trustee to sell said Tract of Land,  
and distribute the nett proceeds, of said sale among the heirs aforesaid.
