Exhibit A. is as follows. viz.

In the name of God - amen. I Henry Starbaugh, of Starbaugh's Valley, in Frederick County, State of Maryland, being in feble health of body, but of disposing mind & memory, do make, and Ordain, the following as my Testament, and last will - First - I direct, that my Just debts, and funeral expenses be first paid by my executor, out of my Estate. Second I give, Constitute, & appoint my Brothers, Elias, and his sons, Jacob & Leonard, executors of this my Testament, & last will, and to enable them to pay my debts, expenses & the legacies bequeathed by this will - I empower them to sell at public, or private sale a Tract of timber Land, containing about one Hundred, and Twenty five acres, call'd "Sugar Tree Valley" Willed to me, by my father, and a Tract of Land, lying in Adams County - Pennsylvania - containing about four Hundred, and seventeen acres, with the usual allowance, deeded to me by Peter Kellenbenger, and his wife, by deed - bearing date 19th Augt. 1824. if I do not dispose of these tracts, by deed, or deeds, of Conveyances, during my life - I direct, that my executors, on the acting - one or ones, or in Case of the death of either the surviving, one or ones to sell the same within three years from my decease, Third I devise to my brother & to his heirs, a Lot of Mountain Land, adjoining lands, belonging to my said brother, lying in Frederick Comty, the lot hereby devised, Contains fifty acres, and is called "Fox Range" and I bequeath to my said Brother George the sum of fifteen Hundred Dollars, to be paid in Two years from my decease, Fourth - I devise to my brother Elias, his heirs, and assigns, my Mansion Farm, willed to me by my father "Called Peace is best" or by whatsoever name the same may be called "Situate in Frederick County aforesaid, also a mountain Lot, of Two hundred and seventeen acres, called "Jacob's Last Chamed, and a mountain Lot of Thirty acres, called "No more" than two Lots, I also received, from my father, I also devise to him, a mountain Lot, I purchased, of Elliotts, and Samuel Godfrey, containing - Seventy five acres "call'd Fox Range. Fifth - I devise and bequeath to my Nephew Henry Shivers three Hundred Dollars, and to each of his sisters Ten Dollars, to be paid in Two years from my decease Sixth, I bequeath to my Nephew, Daniel Starbaugh, son of my brother yock, One hundred Dollars, and to each of his sisters living at the time of my death, Ten dollars, to be paid in two years after my decease, Seventh, I bequeath to each of the Children of my Brother Jacob living at the time of my death, Ten Dollars, to be paid in two years after my decease, Eighth - I bequeath, to each of the Children of my Brother - John living at the time of my decease, five Dollars, in two years after my decease. Lastly - In Consequence of the kind attention of my Brother Elias, and his family, and the many services rendered to me, by them, in addition to the services - made to him, I devise & bequeath to him, all the rest & residue of my Estate. In Witness whereof, I hereunto subscribe my name & affix my seal - this first day of September, 1843.
