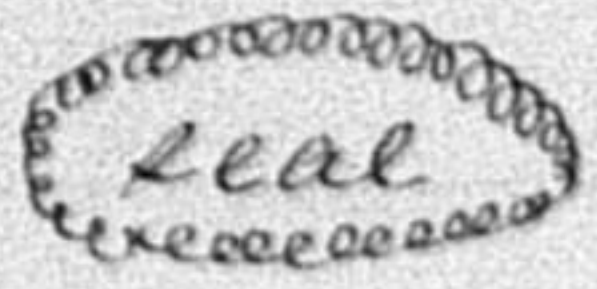

Thereupon the following Instructions to Auditor were filed March 31st 1853.

The Auditor, in stating the new Audit in this case, will charge the Justice with the amount of the sale as heretofore reported, he will then give credit for all the costs and charges allowed in the former audit, and also for the costs of this further proceeding, and allow another Council fee of five dollars, and an appearance of ten dollars, and allow to Daniel Keller, administrator of Rosina Keller deceased, the sum of Three hundred and sixty six dollars and seventy eight cents, the amount overpaid the personal estate by him as shown by the accompanying copy of his final account in the Orphans Court; the balance of the fund he will distribute among the legal heirs of Rosina Keller deceased, as shown by the former audit.
