First Interrogatory. Do you know any of the parties in the

as you know, and the length of time you have known them.

Second Interrogatory - Do you know, or can you say - from any thing coming under your
observation if there is a Firm, in the City of Baltimore, trading as Noah A. Gasaway & Co. if
yea state the names of those composing said Firm, and the kind of Business they have
for several years been engaged in.

Third Interrogatory - Do you know whether, at any time within the last few years, since
the formation of the above partnership of Noah A. Gasaway & Co. there were any dealings
between said Firm, and the said Jacob Beam, if yea, state when - and the nature of such
dealings, state fully your knowledge herein.

Fourth Interrogatory - Look upon the paper now shown you, marked exhibit A. & state
if you at any time presented any of said ap^s to said Beam, and demanded payment -
thereof, if yea, state when it was, and specify the ap, and state what reply was made
by said Beam on the occasion, touching the ap, as to its correctness, or his intention to
pay it, state fully your knowledge on these points, and also state if Beam, at any time,
admitted to you - that there was any thing due by him to said Firm & its amount.

and the nature of such dealings, or business transactions.

Third Interrogatory - Look upon the paper now shown you, marked exhibit A. and state if any
one of the ap^s therein set forth was represented to you - if yea state when it was, by whom
and specify the ap.

Fourth Interrogatory. Did you at any time, whilst dealing with
said Firm become indebted to them if yea state the manner of your indebtedness, and to what
extent, and also state if said Indebtedness has been cancelled, and if not cancelled state
what amount is still due for principal & Interest to said Firm, state fully your knowledge herein
and state if the last, or any of the ap^s rendered is a correct statement of your indebtedness.
