This exhibit C was the last monthly account handed to me, and is the original account. The account Exhibit A. never was handed to me by the Clerk of Noah A. Gasaway & Co. There was a mortgage on my house to secure a note of \$800. which should be deducted from the Balance on Exhibit C. of \$2161.31 the note was paid. I showed several papers to Mr. Kahler about the time of the execution of the mortgage to him, and this paper Exhibit C was among them. There were no further funds furnished me by Noah A. Gasaway & Co. after making the mortgage to Kahler, except perhaps a small draft of \$25.00 I do not know whether the note of \$1200. of William Deam protested March 25. 1853 was ever paid - There being no other witnesses to be examined, and neither party desiring further time for the production of his evidences, the Commission closed the said Commission, and herewith returns the same, under his hand, and seal, with the testimony aforesaid, written-down, and the papers, and exhibits mentioned in the Interrogatories, and answers aforesaid, this sixth day of May, 1854.
