Jeremiah Norwood, and Elvina his wife, John W. Miles, Charles P. Miles

James W. Miles - That your orator, John W. Charles P. and James W. & your oratrix, Catharine S. and Elvina are children, and heirs at law

of Charles Miles, late of Frederick County, deceased, and that Albert F. Miles, and Francis Miles are also children, and heirs at law of said Charles Miles, and are infants under the age of Twenty one years, and that Elizabeth

who intermarried with Cyrus Dudderar, and is since deceased, and who died since the death of said Charles Miles was also a child and heir at law

of said Charles, and that she left at her death the following children to wit Henry Dudderar, Frances Dudderar, George Dudderar, Emily Dudderar, and Charles W. Dudderar, all of whom are infants, under the age of twenty one

years, and that the above named parties, are the heirs at law of said Charles Miles, your orators, and oratrix further shew that the said Charles Miles died

intestate, at Frederick County, on or about the year 1837, and that he was seized, and possessed at the time of his death of a Tract, or parcel of

land, situated lying, and being in said County, containing Two Hundred and Forty seven acres, and three quarters of an acre, more or less, which

composed the Farm, on which he resided at the time of his death, and also two Lots of ground, lying in Hyatts Town, Montgomery County, containing one quarter of an acre each, with the buildings, & Improvements thereon
