


Thereupon the following answer was filed February, 28. 1855.

The separate answer of Almada Miles, to the Bill of Complaint of Isaac Davis, and Catharine his wife, and others, in the Circuit Court, for Frederick County, sitting in Equity exhibited. This respondent, for answer to the said Bill of Complaint, admits to be true, the several matters, and things therein alleged, and set forth, and that it will be for the interest, and advantage of all the parties mentioned in said Bill - that the property, and Estate therein mentioned shall be sold, and the proceeds of sale, divided as prayed. She further states - that she is now fifty five years of age, and that she is willing that the said property - shall be sold free and discharged of her claim of dower therein, and that she is willing to receive in lieu thereof such proportion of the purchase money, as may be allowed her by your Honor.

Thereupon the following Decree was passed.

Testimony taken, and other the proceedings were read, and considered. Whereupon it is this 20th day of April in the year 1855. by the Hon. Madison Nelson, Judge of the Circuit Court, for Frederick County, sitting in Equity, and by his authority, adjudged, Ordered and Decreed that the Real Estate in the Bill, and proceedings mentioned be sold - That Isaac Davis, and John W. Miles be, and they are hereby appointed Trustees to make said sale, and that the course, and manner of their proceedings, shall be as follows. They shall first file with the Clerk of this Court, a Bond - to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of six Thousand Dollars, with Surety to be approved by this Court, or the Clerk thereof. Conditioned for the faithful discharge of the trust reposed in them by this Decree, or to be reposed in them by any future Decree, or order in the premises. They shall then proceed to make said sale, having first given three weeks public Notice by advertisement, in some Newspaper published in Frederick County, and in such other manner as they shall deem proper, of the time, place, manner and Terms of sale, which shall be as follow. one third of the purchase money shall be paid on the day of sale, or on the ratification thereof by this Court, and the balance in two equal annual payments, secured by the Bonds, or Notes of the purchaser, or purchasers, bearing Interest from the day of sale, with security to be approved by the Trustees, and as soon as may be after said sale, the said Trustees shall report to this Court their proceedings, under
