That your Honorable Court, would pass an order requiring the said Trustee to pay over to her as guardian as aforesaid the said sum of \$45.387 after first deducting therefrom the amount of Court Costs, in this Petition, Exhibit and the order of your Honorable Court, to be taxed by the Clerk of said Court and your petitioner will ever pray &c.

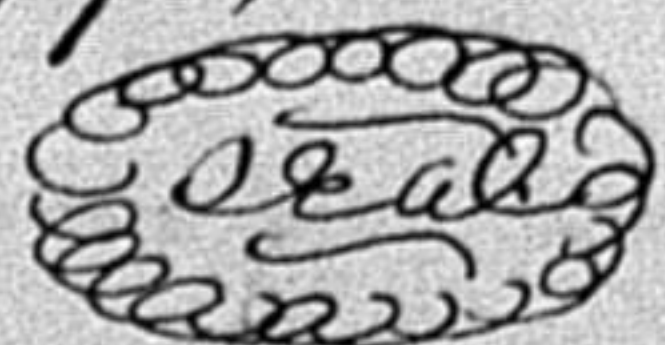
