At the request of Frederick Crabb, the following Deed is Recorded, 22^d day of April 1834. This Indenture - made this 21st day of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand, eight hundred and Thirty four - between Mahlon Salbott Sheriff of Frederick County Maryland, of the one part, and Frederick Crabb of the County and State aforesaid of the other part; Witnesseth, That whereas, on the twenty fifth day of November, eighteen Hundred and Thirty three, a certain writ of the State of Maryland, of Fieri facias did issue forth out of the County Court of the County aforesaid - to the Sheriff of said County directed, reciting - that whereas at a County Court, begun & held at the Court House, in Frederick Town, in and for said County, on the fourth Monday of February, eighteen Hundred, and forty three, the Pres^t Directors, and Company of the Farmers Bank of Maryland by Judgment of the same, recovered against a certain John Eyles, as well the sum of one thousand Dollars, Current money, for the damages, which the said - President, Directors, and Company had sustained by reason of the Nonperformance of a certain promise, and assumption by the said John to the said President, Directors & Company - before that time made, as for the Costs, and charges by them about their suit in that behalf
