And whereas afterwards, to wit: on the 11th day of February 1834, a Certain other writ of the State of Maryland, of *Terri facias* did issue forth out of the County Court of the County aforesaid to the Sheriff of the said County directed, reciting - that whereas at a County Court, begun and held at the Court House, in Frederick - Town, in and for said County on the 23^d day of February, eighteen hundred, and thirty two, a Certain Lewis Mottet by Judgment of the same recovered against a Certain John Eyles, as well the sum of Five thousand Dollars, Current money, for his damages - which he had sustained, as well by reason of the Non - performance of said premises Certain promises, and assumptions before that time to the said John to the said Lewis made, as for his Costs and charges by the said Lewis, about his suit in that behalf laid out - and expended, whereof the said John is Convict, as it appears of Record and whereas afterwards, to wit: on the first day of April, eighteen hundred, and thirty four, a Certain other writ of the State of Maryland of *Terri facias*, did issue forth - out of the County Court of the County aforesaid to the Sheriff of said County directed, reciting - that whereas at a County Court, begun, and held, at the Court House in Frederick Town - in and for said County, on the fourth Monday of October, eighteen hundred and - thirty three - The Bank of Westminster, by Judgment of the same recovered against a Certain John Eyles, Frederick Crabb, and John Vickum the sum of Five thousand Dollars, Current money, for the Damages which the said Bank of Westminster - had sustained, as well by reason of the Non performance of a Certain promise, and assumption by the said John, Frederick & John, to the said Bank of Westminster, before that time made as for the Costs, and Charges by the said Bank of Westminster, about their suit in that behalf, laid out and expended, whereof the said John Eyles, Frederick Crabb, and John Vickum are Convict, as it appears of Record. Therefore you are hereby commanded, that of the goods & Chattels, Lands - and Tenements of the said John, being in your Bailwick you cause to be made the Damages, Costs, and Charges aforesaid, and have you those Sums before the Judges of the next County Court, to be held at the Court house in Frederick - town, in and for said County, on the fourth - Monday of October next, to render unto the said President, Directors, and Company of the Farmers Bank of Maryland, Lewis Mottet, Zachariah Jordan administrator -
