Frederick County to wit: State of Maryland, to the Sheriff of Frederick County Greeting: Whereas at a County Court, begun, and held, at the Court House in Frederick-Town, in and for said County, on the fourth Monday of February last, a certain Frederick Crabbs sen. by a Judgment of the same Court - recovered against a certain John Eyles, as well the sum of nine hundred and twenty six dollars, and Ninety eight-Cents, Current money, for his damages which he had sustained by reason that the Jury empannelled & sworn to try the issues joined between them, gave their verdict for him the said Frederick Crabbs sen. whereof the said John Eyles is convicted, as it appears of Record. Therefore you are hereby Commanded, that of the goods - and chattels, lands, and Tenements of said John Eyles, being in your bailiwick, you cause to be made - the damages, Costs, and Charges aforesaid, and have you those sums, before the Judges of the next County Court, to be held at the Court House, in Frederick-town, in, and for said County, on the fourth Monday of October next, to render unto the said Frederick Crabbs sen. the damages, Costs, and charges, aforesaid. Hereof fail not at your peril, and have you then and there this writ. Witness Thomas Buchanan Esq. associate Judge of the said Court the 24th day of February 1845. Issued 8th day of May 1845. W. B.
