Palmer his attorney - prosecuted, and sued forth out of the Frederick-County Court - of and upon a Judgment - in the said Court rendered, a writ of the State of Maryland of Fieri facias to the Sheriff of Frederick County directed, in the words, and of the tenor following to wit:

State of Maryland to the Sheriff of Frederick County Greeting - whereas at a County Court, begun and held, at the Court House in Frederick-town, in and for said County on the fourth Monday of February last - a certain Frederick Crabbs Senr. by a Judgment of the same Court - recovered against - a certain John Eyles, as well the sum of three thousand dollars current money, for his damages, which he had sustained, as well by reason of the non-performance of a certain promise and assumption - before that time made, as for his costs and charges by him, about his suit expended - in that behalf, whereof the said John Eyles is convicted, as it appears of record. Therefore you are hereby Commanded that of the goods, and Chattels, Lands, and Tenements of the said John Eyles - being in your bailiwick, you cause to be made the damages, costs and charges aforesaid, and have you those sums before the Judges of next County Court to be held at the Court House, in Frederick Town, in & for said County, on the fourth Monday of October next, to render unto the said Frederick Crabbs Senr. - the damages, costs, and charges aforesaid - Hereof fail not, at your peril, and have you then, and there this writ.
