

final account - That your Complainants were Compelled to pay to the said Susan Righter the sum of three hundred and ninety dollars and ninety nine Cents, as will appear by exhibit N^o. 2. and which sum of money was paid by them in discharge of their liability as Securities in said guardian Bond, and which sum of money is still due to them, and unpaid - your Complainants further state - that the said Elizabeth Righter, after the date of said mortgage - married a certain Zachariah Shaw, which said Shaw - at the February Term 1855 of the Circuit Court - for Frederick County, was - Convicted of persuading Slaves to runaway - and was sentenced to Confinement in the penitentiary of this State - for six years, and two months, as will appear by exhibit N^o. 3. and which said Shaw is now in actual Confinement, in the penitentiary - under said sentence, and your Complainants further state, That the said Zachariah Shaw, and Elizabeth Shaw his wife, on the twenty sixth day of July, eighteen hundred, and forty four - to secure to Hugh M^c. Aleen the sum of One Hundred dollars, with Interest from the date, on, or before the first day of April, in the year, eighteen hundred, and forty five - Conveyed by deed of mortgage to said Hugh M^c. Aleen - the Land, and premises above described as will fully appear by a Certified Copy of said mortgage - herewith exhibited, marked, exhibit N^o. 4 which sum of money your Complainants have been informed is still due, and unpaid - Do the end therefore - that the said Elizabeth Shaw, and Hugh M^c. Aleen may answer the several matters, and things herein before stated - as fully and particularly as if specially interrogated thereto, and that the premises aforesaid, or so much thereof as may be necessary, may be sold, for payment of the claim of your Complainants - with all interest thereon, and that your Complainants - may have such other, or further relief - in the premises - as the natural, and Equity of their case may require - May it please your Honor to grant to your Complainants the writ of Subpoena, against the said Elizabeth Shaw, and Hugh M^c. Aleen, of Frederick County, directed to the Sheriff of the said County - Commanding them to appear in this Court, by a certain day to be therein named - to answer the premises, and abide by, and perform such decree as may be passed therein - and as induly bound &c.
