 County February Term 1855. Indicted for persuading slaves
 Zachariah Shaw } to run away.
 1855. March 5th Plea Not Guilty, and issue. Jury empanelled & sworn. Verdict Guilty &
 Motion for new trial reasons filed &c. 1855 March 8th. It is considered by the Court here
 that Zachariah Shaw - the above named prisoner, undergo a confinement in the
 penitentiary House of this state for the period of six years & two months, and
 thereupon - he is committed to the Sheriff of Frederick County, to be by him
 safely removed at the expense of the County aforesaid, to said Penitentiary House
 therein to be kept &c &c.
