Be it remembered, and it is hereby Certified that on this 26th day of July, in the year of our Lord, one thousand, eight hundred, and forty four - before the subscriber, two Justices of the peace of the State of Maryland, in and for the aforesaid County personally appeared Zachariah Shaw, & Elizabeth Shaw his wife, they being known to us, to be the persons, who are named, & described as, & professing to be the parties to the foregoing deed, or Indenture, and doth severally acknowledge the said Indenture, or Instrument of writing - to be their respected act, & deed, the said Elizabeth Shaw, having signed, and sealed said Indenture before us, out of the presence, and hearing of her husband, and the said Elizabeth Shaw being by us examined, out of the presence and hearing of her said husband, whether she doth execute, and acknowledge the same freely, and voluntarily, & without being induced to do so, by fear or threats of, or ill usage by her said husband, or by fear of his displeasure, do declare and faith that she doth.
