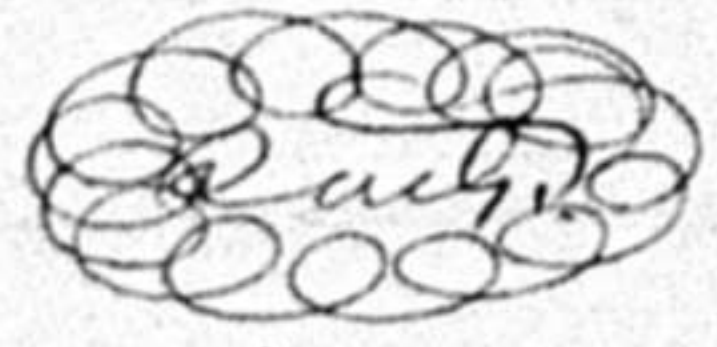


Exhibit N. 4 is in the following words & figures to wit:
At the request of Thomas Crampton, the following deed is Recorded, the 26th day of April 1856. This Indenture - made this 23rd day of April, in the year of our Lord, One thousand, eight hundred, and Thirty six - between Otho Thomas & Harriet Thomas of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and Thomas Crampton of the County, and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth That the said Otho Thomas, and Harriet Thomas, for & in consideration of the sum of six thousand six hundred, and fifteen Dollars, current money, to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Crampton - the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and from every part, and paid thereof, doth hereby acquit, exonerate & discharge the said Thomas Crampton, his heirs, executors & administrators they the said Otho Thomas, and Harriet Thomas, hath granted, bargained sold, aliened, enfeoffed, and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell, alien, enfeoff, and confirm, unto the said Thomas Crampton his heirs and assigns, part of a Tract of Land, "called" The Resurvey on Maryland being part of Lots No. 19, & 20. and part of a Tract of Land called Hawkins Merry peep a day. It being the same Land, that was sold, to the said Otho Thomas by Tobias Bell as the Trustee of Jeremiah Bell, on the 30th day of December in the year of our Lord 1830. and which parts, pieces, or parcels of Land aforesaid - & hereby intended to be conveyed are contained within the following courses, limits, notes, and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a planter stone, at the end of 659 ps. on the South line of the aforesaid Tract of Land "called" The Resurvey on Maryland, and running thence South 66³/₄° east 157 ps. to a planter stone, then South 45³/₄° east 19 ps. to a planter stone, it being the Beginning of a Tract of Land "called" John & Priscilla" then with the first line of said John & Priscilla, South 52 degrees west 102 ps. then N. 70° west 94⁸/₁₀ ps. then S 10¹/₂° W 255 ps. then S 84¹/₂° W 34 ps. then N 19¹/₄° east 60 ps. then N 10° West 117 ps. then N 67° West 17¹/₂ ps. then N 13° E 40 ps. to a large marked poplar Tree, then N. 26° east 47¹/₂ ps. to a marked Beach Tree then N 42³/₄° East 102¹/₂ ps. to a Sycamore Stump, then N 27¹/₂° east 21³/₄ ps to the Beginning - Containing one Hundred & eighty nine acres of Land, more or less.
