The Bill of Complaint of John Lorentz of Frederick County, State of Maryland, who sues as well for himself as all other creditors of Jacob Flook of Dec. late of Frederick County State of Maryland dec^d. who may hereafter come in, and contribute to the expenses of this suit - Respectfully sheweth - That the said Jacob Flook of John - by his sealed Note, dated on the seventh day of December, eighteen hundred and fifty two, and payable thirty days after date - was, and still continues indebted unto the said John Lorentz, in the sum of sixty nine Dollars, with Interest from date, as will appear by the said sealed note, herewith exhibited, marked, exhibit N^o 1, which your Complainant prays - together with all other exhibits hereinafter produced, may be taken as a part of this his Bill of Complaint - your Complainant further states - That the said Jacob Flook of John died intestate, on, or about the fifteenth day of April, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty three, intestate, seized & possessed of the following parts of Tracts of Land, situate in Frederick County, State of Maryland, viz. part of a Tract of Land, called "The Resurvey on the Bloomington mouth of May" containing twenty three acres of Land, more or less, part of a Tract of Land "called" "Chevezes" containing fifty seven acres of Land more or less, and part of a Tract of Land "called The Resurvey, on Locust Level" heretofore conveyed by Abraham Snyder - to said Jacob Flook, of John, containing about sixteen acres of Land, more or less, being the entire Real Estate of said Jacob Flook of John, in the County and State aforesaid owned, and occupied by him, at the time of his death, your Complainant further states - that the said Jacob Flook of John, left a widow - named - Barbara Flook, and the following Children, and heirs at Law, him surviving to wit: a son named John H. Flook, who married Elizabeth Bowles, who reside in Washington County, State of Maryland - Daniel B. Flook, who married Elizabeth Mumma a daughter Elizabeth Flook, who married Dewatt Williard, a son Jacob C. Flook, who married Susan Smetzer a daughter, Eleine E. Flook, who married Henry Jarboe, a daughter Catharine C. Flook, who married Joshua Roubatin - a son John Philip Flook a daughter Lydia Flook, all of whom are of full age, and reside in Frederick County - except Henry Jarboe, and Eveline E. Jarboe his wife, who are non residents -
