This Indenture - made this 20th day of June, in the year of our Lord, One thousand Eight Hundred, and Forty one - Between John M. Elfesh & his wife Theresia M. Elfesh of Frederick County, and State of Maryland of the one part & Gideon Bantz of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesses, that the said John M. Elfesh, & his wife Theresia M. Elfesh, for & in Consideration of the sum of six hundred, & seventy five dollars, current money to them, in hand paid by the said Gideon Bantz, at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, Enfeoffed & Confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien Enfeoff & Confirm, unto him the said Gideon Bantz, his heirs & assigns, all theirs the said John M. Elfesh & his wife Theresia M. Elfesh's estate right title, Claim, & interests both at Law, & Equity, of in and to all that Lot or portion of ground, Situate, lying and being in Frederick Town & County aforesaid, which was heretofore conveyed by Henry M. Elfesh to John M. Elfesh, the said Lot, or portion of ground hereby intended -
