This Indenture, made this Twenty fourth day of October, Eighteen hundred and fifty three, between William F. Johnson, and Elizabeth his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and Green Bantz of the County, and State aforesaid of the other part; Witnesseth, That for and in Consideration of the sum of six hundred Dollars, Current money by the said Green Bantz to the said William F. Johnson, Elizabeth, in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivering of these presents, the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge, and themselves to be therewith fully satisfied, contented, and paid, the said William F. Johnson, hath bargained & sold, aliened, and enfeoffed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, alien, enfeoff, release, Convey, and Confirm unto the said Green Bantz, his heirs, and assigns, all the following described piece, or parcel of Land, situate, and lying, in Frederick County, & State aforesaid, it being part of Lot No. 14. part of a Tract of Land, Called The Resurvey on Tuscorora, Beginning for the same, in the middle of the New Cut Road, leading from Frederick Town, through Hamburg on the mountains, and at the end of 110 ps. on the 2^d line of the whole lot No. 14. and running thence by & with by, and with said 2^d line N. 77° W. 340 ps. to the end of 187 ps. on the seventh line of the whole Tract Called "The Resurvey on Tuscorora, then with said line reversed, South 5° West 58 ps. to a stake & heap of stones, at the end of the second line of lot No. 3. then by and with said line reversed, it being the closing line of lot No. 11. S 77° E. 406. ps. to the south margin of the Hamburg Road aforesaid, then by and with said Road N. 5° West. 12 ps. N 38 1/4° West. 22 ps. N. 60° W. 27 ps. N 32 1/2° W. 14 ps. N 25 1/2° W. 80 ps. then by a straight line, to the place of beginning Containing one hundred & thirty four & one fourth acres of Land, more or less, also all that Lot, or portion of grounds distinguished as lot No. 6. being part of Lot No. 2. & No. 3 which were parts of The Resurvey on Tuscorora" Containing within the following metes, and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake, and a heap of stones, near a Chestnut tree - Standing at the end of 184 ps. on the 2^d line of said Lot No. 3. it being also the end of the 3^d line of lot No. 5. Conveyed to Nicholas Stolby, by deed dated, on, or about the 7th day of December 1831. and running thence with it reversed S. 25 1/4° West. 133 ps. to a stake and heap of stones, at the end of the second line of said Lot No. 5. & on the 8th line of lot No. 2. aforesaid, then with said 8th line reversed N. 66° W. 54 ps. to a stake and heap of stones near a chestnut oak tree, marked with 9 chops, then N. 16° E. 119 1/2 ps. to a stake & heap of stones at the end of 258 1/2 ps. on the 2^d line of the said Lot No. 3 then with it reversed to the Beginning Containing Fifty acres of Land, it being the same several pieces, or parcels of Land, and premises, Conveyed to the said William F. Johnson by Philip Reich, and his wife, by Indenture, bearing date, on the 10th
