

between them, share and share alike, subject nevertheless, and upon the following express conditions, that is to say, the said Israel and Ann Mary, their heirs or assigns, shall take & remove the before mentioned Weaver Shop, that is now on the part of said lot of grounds, devised to my mother, and shall build & erect the said Shop, on the front part of said lot, devised to my sister Charlotte, and that the said Israel, and Mary shall jointly furnish in complete order, the front part of said Shop for a room, and the other part thereof for a kitchen, as also to have a cellar dug underneath said Shop.

I also give and bequeath to my sister Charlotte, to her, and her heirs & assigns, all my part and one half of the Land, six Shoats, and all my Corn, and also the wheat, which may be left, at the time of my death, and all the Crop of grain that may be then growing on her dower, in and to the aforesaid forty nine & a half acres of Land, part of Murdock's Farm, aforesaid. Item, I give and bequeath - to my said niece Mary the eldest daughter of my brother Israel, to her, and her heirs and assigns my high Bedstead, together with all the bed Clothes &c. belonging thereto, and my gilded looking Glass, my Bureau, one wouful Iron, all my Liverpool China, two flowered white Glass Bottles, six Red flowered plates, and my wheat Fan.

Item, My will is, and I order & Direct That Charlotte Daily, her heirs or assigns shall not, during the time she or they may occupy the said 27³/₈ acres part of the land called "Shiner stat", cut any wood growing thereon, but may take such of the wood that is decayed, or fallen, and I further direct that no wood shall be cut, on the twenty & a half acres part of "Puzzlesome Corseted" further than may be necessary for the fencing of the 27³/₈ acres part of "Waver stat".

Item - I give and Devise and bequeath unto my Brother Israel Myers, and my Sister Ann Mary wife of Jacob Wall, their heirs & assigns, all the rest, and residue of my Estate of which I may die seized, to be equally divided between them, share and share alike and the express Conditions, that is to say, that they shall jointly pay all my debts, and Israel, and his heirs, or assigns shall pay to my mother the sum of Forty dollars, current money, yearly, and every year, and twelve Bushels of wheat yearly, and every year, and furnish her, with as much firewood as she may want yearly and every year, during her life, and that the said Ann Mary, wife of Jacob Wall, and her heirs shall pay unto my mother aforesaid the sum of Forty dollars, yearly, and every year, during her life.


And lastly, I do hereby constitute, and appoint my beloved mother Israel Myers, and my brother in law Jacob Wall, to be jointly and severally, my executors of this my last will and Testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made ratifying this & none other to be my last will & Testament.

In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand, and affixed my seal this seventeenth day of January, in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred, and twenty four.
