This Indenture made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of March. 1849. between John Buzzard & Susanna Buzzard his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland of the one part; and David Forrest & John Forrest of the County and State aforesaid of the other part; Witnesseth - That the said John Buzzard & Susanna his wife, for & in Consideration of the sum of Seven hundred & eighty seven Dollars & fifty cents current money, to them in hand paid David David & John Forrest, the receipt whereof the said John Buzzard, and Susanna his wife, do hereby acknowledge & themselves therewith to be fully satisfied and paid, hath granted bargained & sold, aliened released, enfeoffed & Confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien released, enfeoff. & Confirm unto the said David Forrest, & John Forrest their heirs & assigns, all the following described parcel of Land, being Lot No. 2. part of a Tract of Land, called "Three Mill Seats" lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid. Beginning for said parcel of Land, at the end of 171<sup>st</sup> line of the whole tract, and running thence S 1<sup>o</sup> W 48 ps. then N. 20<sup>o</sup> W. 158 ps. to the end of 48 ps. on the 175<sup>th</sup> line of the aforesaid Land." called "Three Mill Seats" and with said line N. 22<sup>o</sup> E. 68 ps. to the end thereof, then with a straight line to the Beginning Containing fifty two acres & a half of Land, more or less. Together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining unto them the said David Forrest & John Forrest, their heirs & assigns forever; to the only proper use & behoof, of them the said David & John Forrest, their heirs & assigns, and to no other use, intent, or purpose whatsoever; and the said John Buzzard, and Susanna his wife, for themselves & their heirs do hereby Covenant & agree to, and with the said David Forrest & John Forrest, their heirs and assigns that they will warrant & defend the aforesaid Lot, or parcel of Land with the appurtenances to them the said David & John Forrest, their heirs, and assigns, against them the said John Buzzard and Susanna his wife and their heirs and against all persons claiming any right by, or under them, or any of them.
