Forrest, or David Forrest. 3. Because the auditor instating said audit has rejected, and disallowed the claim of this exceptant, which was a lien on said property, and is a lien on the proceeds of sale in the hands of the trustee, and allowed and audited the whole of the balance of the trust funds to said Samuel Wolfe, in part of his pretended claim, which if it ever existed was no lien, on said land, or on the proceeds of sale in the hands of the trustee. For the above reasons, this exceptant prays the Court to reject the said Report of the auditor, and to refer the said case to the auditor with instructions to allow the judgment of this exceptant, as the first lien - out of the said trust funds, after having made the proper equitable allowance to said widows, in lieu of dower.
