



Enfeoffed, and Confirmed, and by these presents, the said Richard Potts doth hereby grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, enfeoff, and Confirm unto the said Henry Zeal, and his heirs, all that part of the Tract of land, called Pipe Meadow, and of the Tract of Land, called "The Resurvey on Meadow, which is included within the following limits, to-wit":

Beginning for the same, at the beginning of a Tract of Land called Stumbling Block, it being the end of the fourth line of the part of the Resurvey on Meadow, conveyed to the said Richard Potts by a certain Michael Raymet, and running thence with said part of the Resurvey on Meadow reversed N 80° W. 18 ps. N 39° E. 4 1/2 ps. to the Middle of the Mill Road, and then with the Middle of said Road South 61° West 21 1/4 ps. then leaving the road South 36 1/4° West 42 ps. to the Beginning of said Resurvey on Meadow, and still with it reversed, S 36 1/4° West 8 ps. to a locust stake at the end of the seventh line of Tasters Chance, S 53 1/4° W. 10 ps. to a locust stake planted on the 8th line of Tasters Chance, it being a Corner of a lot of ground, conveyed by Michael Raymet to James Beatty, then South 12 1/4° E. 14 ps. to a stake N 61° E. 5 1/2 ps. to a stake N 36° E. 4 3/4 ps. to a stake N 33 1/2° W. 4 1/4 ps. to a stake S 60 1/2° W. 20 1/4 ps. to a stake N 84 1/2° E. 11 ps. to a stake S 72 1/2° E. 4 1/2 ps. the given line of the said Stumbling Block, thence with it to the Beginning, containing eight acres & one quarter of an acre of land, Together with all and singular the buildings, Improvements, advantages, and appurtenances to the same belonging, or appertaining To Have and to Hold the said Eight acres, & one quarter of an acre of land, and all the estate, rights, and title of the said Richard Potts to the same, to him the said Henry Zeal, his heirs & assigns forever, to the only proper use, and behoof of the said Henry Zeal, his heirs and assigns forever, and to & for no other use, intent, or purpose whatsoever, and the said Richard Potts doth hereby for himself, and his heirs Covenant and agreed to & with the said Henry Zeal, his heirs & assigns, to warrant & defend to him, and thence the said Eight acres, & one quarter of an acre of land, from and against him the said Richard Potts, and all claims under him
