

Exhibit N<sup>o</sup> 4. is in the words & figures following to wit.

In the name of God amen. J. Henry Feiler of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland being of sound and disposing mind, do make, and publish this my last will & Testament, in manner & form following - that is to say. First and principally I Commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executor hereinafter named, and after my debts, and funeral Charges are paid. I devise as bequeath as follows. I give and devise to my son in law John Brungle, and his heirs, upon the Trust, and for the uses hereinafter mentioned, all that Lot, or parcel of Land, containing about Ten acres, more or less, with the Improvements thereon Situate near Frederick Town, and on the road from said Town to Johnsons Mill, on which said Lot I have erected a One story Brick House a Barn, and Smiths Shop. in Trust that the said John Brungle, and his heirs shall permit my daughter Margaret Hamman to hold, use, and occupy the same, and to take, have and receive the rents, issues and profits thereof, during her natural life, to her own separate use, in the same manner as if she were a feme sole, and without the interference of her present, or any future husband, and upon the death of the said Margaret Hamman, then in trust that the said John Brungle, and his heirs shall hold the said Land, and premises to the use of my two children George Feiler & Elizabeth Brungle wife of the said John Brungle and my Grand Children, the Children of my daughter Margaret Hamman aforesaid, their heirs, and assigns forever, to be equally divided in the following manner, that is to say. To my son George Feiler one third part thereof, to my daughter Elizabeth Brungle, one third part thereof, and to the Children of my daughter Margaret Hamman the remaining third thereof, or to their and each of their respective heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Maria Beyer (of Kentucky) her heirs, and assigns, Thirty Bank Shares, vested by me, in the Westminster Bank, which she may draw for as soon as she, or they may think proper after my death, which shall be in full of her part, or share of my Estate. I give and bequeath to each of my three Grand Children the daughters of my deceased son Adam Feiler, namely, Louisa, Ann Maria, and Elizabeth the Interest of six shares of Bank Stock vested by me, in the Westminster Bank, to be used, and appropriated by my executor, for the support & maintenance of my said three grand Children during their minority, and when any of them shall respectively arrive to full age, they and each of them shall and may take and receive and have the sole management of their separate and respective six shares of Stock aforesaid, in full of their, and each of their part, or share of my Estate. I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Brungle her heirs and assigns my negro boy Lloyd. In consequence of this bequest to my daughter Elizabeth, and for the purpose of quieting my son George Feiler, I desire and request, and do order that his note payable to me for fourteen hundred Dollars with all the Interest thereon shall be given up, and delivered to him, or his heirs free, and clear of all, and every charge, or demand. All the rest, & residue of my Estate real, personal, or mixed of whatsoever nature, or kind the same may be, and all my money notes, Bonds, Bank Stock, accounts & property of every kind, not herein before bequeathed, I give & bequeath to my three Children, George Feiler, Elizabeth Brungle, and Margaret Hamman and their heirs, to be equally divided between them, share and share alike.

Nevertheless my will, and desire is, and I do order & direct that the Share-
