And whereas I have hereinbefore given, devised, and bequeathed to my son Henry, more than an equal share of my estate, in order to recompense him for having done more service for me than any other of my children. Nevertheless should my son Henry be disposed, after my death, to bring an account, or charge against my estate for services done me, my will in such case is, and I order & direct that the said account, or charge (if any) shall be taken from & deducted out of his share of the money arising from the sale, and collection of my estate. Lastly I do hereby constitute, and appoint my worthy and much respected brother in law John Brugh, sole executor of this my last will & Testament revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made.

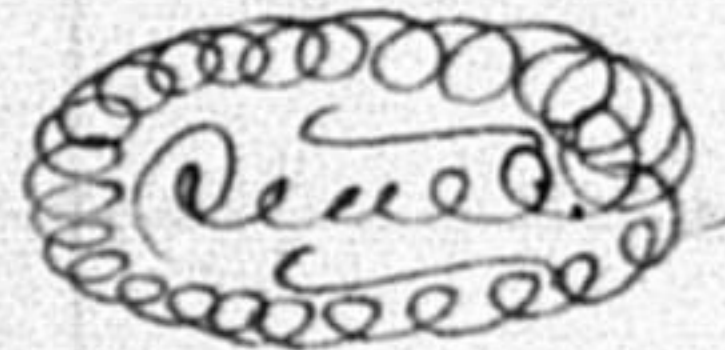
