 Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity. The bill of Com-
 plaint of Allen G. Luzym and John Alfred Ritter of Frederick County, State
 of Maryland, who sue as well for themselves as all other Creditors of Griffin
 Taylor, late of said County dec'd. who will come in and contribute to the
 expenses of this suit, humbly shows - that the said Griffin Taylor was
 in his life time, indebted unto your orators, in the sum of Three hundred
 and seventy four Dollars, eighty & one half Cents current money, on an open
 account, dated January 3^d. 1855 & ending on September 11th of same year,
 for sundry matters & things, properly chargeable in account, which
 is herewith exhibited, marked exhibit No. 1. which your Complainants
 pray together with all other exhibits, herein produced, may be taken &
 considered as part of this their Bill of Complaint.

And your orators further charge, that the said Griffin Taylor being indebted
 as aforesaid, unto your orators, & also unto divers other persons in large
 sums of money, and having Real, and personal Estate of great Value, de-
 parted this life, in the year of our Lord, one thousand Eight Hundred and
 fifty five, intestate, and leaving Susan A. R. Taylor his widow, Eliza-
 beth Leigh Johnson, who has intermarried with Dr. Richard Johnson, Alex-
 ander M. Comb Taylor, Francis D. Taylor, Robert Mackall Taylor, Eugene Au-
 gustus Taylor, Charles James Taylor, Ann Virginia Corum Taylor, Griffin Ewd.
 Taylor, Victorie Chelton Taylor, his children, and heirs at law, all living in
 the aforesaid County, & State, except Dr. Richard D. Johnson & Elizabeth Leigh
 Johnson his wife, who reside in the State of Missouri, but are now in
 Frederick County Maryland, and are prepared to answer this bill therefrom,
 and Alexander M. Comb Taylor, who is out of the State & whose residence
 is not known to your orators, and your Complainants further charge
 that the said Alexander M. Comb Taylor, Francis Dzyerzynski Taylor, Robert
 Mackall Taylor, Eugene Augustus Taylor, Charles James Taylor, Ann Virgin-
 ia Corum Taylor, Griffin Ewd Taylor, Victorie Chelton Taylor are Infants
 under the age of Twenty one years, and your orators further charge that
 the said Griffin Taylor died intestate as to his Real Estate, seized & possessed
 in fee Simple of the following pieces, or parts of Tracts of Land, Situate in
 the County, and State aforesaid, to wit: all that Tract, or part of a Tract
 of Land, "called" "Supply" Containing 12 acres, & 21 ps. of Land, also all that
 part of a Tract of Land "called" "Araby", containing 47a. 3. R. & 27 ps. both
 of which said parcels of Land were heretofore conveyed by William J. Ross,
 as Trustee for John M. Pherson, and Fanny R. McPherson his wife to Griffin
 Taylor, by dec'd. a true Copy whereof is herewith exhibited marked exhibit
