


Sealed with our seals & dated this 20<sup>th</sup> day of May 1857

Whereas, by a Decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting in Equity bearing date on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1857 and passed in a Cause pending on said Court between Charles Goldbrough as Complainant & Mary Drwills &c and others as defendants, being No 2684 Equity in said Court the said Thomas Picking was appointed Trustee in the place & stead of William Ott to complete the Trust in said Case Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Picking do & shall well & faithfully perform the Trust reposed in him by said Decree, or which may be reposed in him by any future Decree or order in the premises, then the above obligation shall be void otherwise to be, and remain in full force & virtue in law.
